This was the start of a consuming passion which would influence Sylvie's entire life and whole existence – not always with the family's approval!

Sylvie's passion has taken her around the world, firstly as an exhibitor, and then as a judge. Although Sylvie's original interest for the King Charles remains, and this breed will always hold a special place in her heart, she has developed a passion for all breeds, and loves the thrill she feels when standing in front of an outstanding exhibit, whatever the breed.

Beginning her judging career in the early 90's, Sylvie became an All Rounder in 2010. Sylvie has judged widely across the world, on most continents at many of the most well documented shows, including World Dog Shows and European Dog Shows. Sylvie is so often complimented about her ring manner and friendliness and respect towards exhibitors and their dogs.

Sylvie's last trip to Australia was in 2015 to judge Perth Royal Show. Sylvie Desserne is a wonderful dog person passionate about her breeds and judging. We look forward to welcoming Sylvie to her first Melbourne Royal Show.

PAMELA BRUCE (CANADA)

Pamela is a fourth generation 'dog person' with deep Hound and Terrier experience. She completed her first champion at age four, alongside her parents who bred Maltese and Lhasa Apsos. Pam has handled and appreciates a wide variety of breeds in various groups. Her expertise is in coated breeds, having conditioned and presented numerous top Hounds, Terriers and Toys, including all varieties of Poodles and also Bearded Collies. Pamela has also bred and exhibited top winning Weimaraners.

For over forty years Pamela specialised in the breed she is best known for – Afghans. She piloted many 'Grandeur' Afghans into the top ten both in Canada and the USA. Pamela's first Airedale Terrier was obtained when she was still a child. Her Terrier mentors included Peter Green, Susan Rogers and Ernesto Lara. She has bred Airedale Terriers under the 'Accolade' prefix for the past 20 years, being highly competitive within the breed as an owner handler and presenting her own dogs.

Pamela is an CKC/AKC All Breeds Judge. Her judging journey began in 2000 and her assignments have taken Pamela around the world over the past twenty years. She has judged in Canada, USA, Chile, Colombia, Korea, Mexico, Australia and Japan. Memorable shows include Westminster Kennel Club, AKC at Orlando, Hatboro KC and Woofstock.

Pamela is a Life Member of the Canadian Kennel Club, having served three terms on the Discipline Committee. She is a valued supporter of judges training, being in charge of the organisation and running of Judges Training in Canada.

Pamela is a retired investigator with the Toronto Police Service Sex Crimes Unit – declared an expert, specialising in DNA 'cold cases', dangerous offenders and sexual assault child abuse investigations.

It is more than nine years since Pamela was last in Australia. We are delighted to welcome Pamela, an outstanding judge and 'dog person' with so many years of wonderful experience, to our 2024 Melbourne Royal Show judging panel.

ZEFERINO SILVA (PORTUGAL)

Zeferino Silva is an All Rounder judge residing outside Porto in Portugal.

More than 45 years ago he began his career in purebred dogs exhibiting and breeding English Cocker Spaniels.

After 1982, under the prefix "Temple's Knight", he commenced breeding and showing American Cocker Spaniels. With some success he bred and presented many American Cockers in competitions, gaining Championship titles with more than 50 dogs.

Zeferino also bred and exhibited Afghans and Whippets for some years.

Currently, in partnership with Rui Oliveira, he breeds and exhibits English Pointers under the prefix "Vale Carvoeiro". This kennel has achieved outstanding results and many dogs carrying this prefix have won well across the globe.

In 1989, with some other breeders, he founded the Portuguese Spaniel Club, where he stayed as President for a number of years. During the same period he was also involved in foundation and direction of the Portuguese Sighthound Club. Zeferino was also Vice President of Portuguese Kennel Club.

Zeferino began his judging career in 1995. He is now an all rounder, having judged widely across the globe, renowned for his fair, honest and well considered decisions. He has judged at National, International and Breed Speciality Shows, in many European countries, together with countries across six continents including Canada, Mexico, Brazil, Peru, Puerto Rico, Colombia, Equador, India, Taiwan, China, Thailand, Peru, México, South Africa, Kenya, Australia, New Zealand, Philippines and South Korea. Zeferino has been honoured to be invited to judge at both the European Dog Show and the World Dog Show.

Zeferino was last in Australia six years ago, and this will be his first trip to Melbourne. He is a successful breeder and widely experienced judge and Melbourne Royal is thrilled to welcome another excellent Portuguese judge to the 2024 Judging Panel.

CAROL MULCAHY (IRELAND)

Carol Mulcahy is a third-generation dog person through her father and grandfather, both of whom enjoyed a great passion with the German Shepherd breed. She has been involved in the dog world for her entire life, as a breeder, exhibitor and since 1996 as a judge.

Carol's breed involvement is mainly in the Collie Rough. Along with her husband John, breeding under the 'Kazjs' prefix since 1974. Breeder of over 57 Champions, 2 Supreme Champions, 4 Grand Champions and 5 International Champions is testament to the success of the kennel. Kazjs Collies have won many top awards and a significant number of multiple Best in Show winners, both Specialty and All Breeds – taking over 100 Best in Shows between them.

Carol's judging journey began in her home group – the Working/Pastoral group. Over the years she has progressed through to become an FCI All Rounder, together with being licenced to judge Junior Handlers. Carol is an astute, considerate and knowledgeable judge of high international standing, enjoying appointments across many countries and continents. She had the honour of judging BIS at the prestigious Rose of Kota Show in Finland, together with giving the final BIS nod in Japan and Sweden.

Carol's experience has seen her judging in Australia, New Zealand, Indonesia, Ireland, Denmark, Sweden, Norway, Germany, Belgium, Canada, Croatia, Russia, South Africa, Switzerland, Netherlands, and most recently at the highly acclaimed Kinky International Show in Japan.

Carol was involved with the Judges Training Scheme in NSW and is a past Group Coordinator for Working Dogs. She has presented lectures, mainly on Pastoral/Working Breeds in Australia, Ireland and other regions of the world. She is also renowned for her Collie Rough and Smooth Grooming Seminars in many countries. She had long standing involvement in both the Collie Club of NSW, holding various positions, together with being Patron of the Belgian Shepherd Club of NSW for over a decade.

Since moving to Ireland over a decade ago, Carol's last visit to our shores was to judge at the Dogs ACT Advance Epic Extravaganza in 2019. It will be our absolute pleasure to welcome Carol back to our shores to join the 2024 Melbourne Royal Judging Panel.

MICHAEL CAMAC (SA) SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Michael Camac has been involved in the Dog World since 1968 as a successful breeder, exhibitor and exporter of Australian Silky Terriers under the "Dulcannina" prefix and as an exhibitor of all three varieties of Poodles, Pharaoh Hounds and Lhasa Apso.

From the age of ten he handled his family's dogs in the show ring and later became a partner in the kennel. The kennel made up approximately 100 Champions and Dulcannina bred and owned the first Silky Terrier to win Best Exhibit in Show at a Royal Show within Australia (Melbourne Royal 1972).

In addition to his involvement with Silky Terriers, Michael co-owned and handled the white Standard Poodle Australian Champion Leander White Blazer (Imp. South Africa) to Best Exhibit in Show at Sydney Royal Easter Show 1988.

Since 1997 Michael has been involved with Lhasa Apsos with great success as a partner in the "Amesen" prefix including winning multiple Best in Group and Group placements at Royal shows within Australia, Multiple Best in Shows (All Breeds) and Multiple Speciality Best in Shows. Amesen has bred approximately 100 Champions, including the first Australian Bred Lhasa Apso to gain an English Show Title.

Michael was first approved to judge Toy Breeds in 1978 and achieved ALL BREEDS status in 1989. He has officiated at shows in all States of Australia, together with international appointments in Sweden, Norway, Finland, New Zealand, India, Canada, Thailand, Philippines, Indonesia, China and Japan. One highlight was judging at the 2008 World Dog Show in Sweden.

He has been invited twice to lecture on Silky Terriers to the Terrier Judges at the Terrier Derby Conferences in Sweden. He judged the Pedigree Chum Junior Showmanship Final at Crufts in 1994.

He was the Group Seven (Non Sporting Group) co-ordinator for many years and is currently an Examiner, Assessor and Breed Lecturer with Dogs SA Judges Training.

Michael served as an elected council member of the South Australian Canine Association for four years and is currently a member of the Adelaide Royal Dog Section Committee.

Entry Closing Date

Entries to the Melbourne Royal All Breeds Championship Show held at the 2024 Melbourne Royal Show close at 5pm, Tuesday 6 August 2024, excluding Baby Puppy entries which close at 5pm, Tuesday 20 August 2024.

General and Special Regulations

The Melbourne Royal All Breeds Championship Show is conducted under the General and Special Regulations of Melbourne Royal and the Rules and Regulations of Dogs Victoria form part of the conditions of entry.

Special Regulations override any General Regulations where a conflict occurs.

How to Enter

Entries for Conformation (all classes), Sweepstakes (all classes) and Action Dog (all classes) can be made via the online entry system.

The online entry system can be accessed via <u>www.melbourneroyal.com.au</u>. Simply click onto the Melbourne Royal Show button and then select 'Dogs' from the drop down menu. If entering using the Melbourne Royal online entry system please ensure that you read all user instructions, terms and conditions prior to entering. Payment can be made by either Visa or MasterCard.

Junior Showmanship

Junior competitors will be required to provide their name, an email address and a mobile phone number to enter. Entries can be completed until 3pm on the day that you wish to compete. If you wish to compete on multiple days, you will need to enter for each day.

Registration opportunities will be available at the Administration office (located in Pavilion 19).

If you are competing on multiple days, you will need to collect new numbers each day you are competing.

Breed Specialty

Entries for Breed Club Specialty Show Competitions are managed by each participating Breed Club. Exhibitors interested in entering their Breed Specialty are requested to contact their Breed Club and lodge their entry with that organisation, who will then organise your entry.

Conditions, Rules and Regulations Pertaining to *Entering and Competing*

Exhibitors are advised to read all of the regulations and conditions that pertain to entering and participating at the 2024 Melbourne Royal All Breeds Championship Show. Regulations and conditions can be located under entries at <u>www.melbourneroyal.com.au/dogs</u>. Exhibitors will be required to comply in full with the regulations and conditions pertaining to entry.

All dogs must be benched from 9am until 5pm.

The age of all dogs is to be calculated as at the first day of CONFORMATION judging (Friday 27 September 2024).

All dogs shall be entered in only one Ordinary Class. (Sweepstakes classes are not considered Ordinary Classes) All dogs entered in Baby Puppy, Puppy, and Champion Sweepstakes must also be entered in one Ordinary Class (exception made only for those exhibits entered into Neutered or Veteran Sweepstakes classes).

Breed Club Specialty Show Competitions

Breed Club Specialty Show Competitions are held in conjunction with the Melbourne Royal All Breeds Championship Show.

Exhibitors wishing to enter their Breed Specialty are to contact their Breed Club for entry details. The participating Breed Club is responsible for managing all entries for the Breed Specialty Shows. Melbourne Royal does not organise the entries or benching for these entries.

Junior Showmanship Conditions of Entry

Entries for Junior Showmanship Competition are required to be lodged on the day up until 3pm on the day of heat judging. See the 'How to Enter' section on page 14 of this schedule.

Entrants can continue to compete until qualified to compete in the finals (eligible if winner of 1st place in a heat). The winner of each heat will be invited to return to compete in the final on General Specials Day. Should the winner of a heat be unable to return on General Specials Day, the second place winner will then compete in the finals. This must be arranged and confirmed by both parties with the Program Coordinator by 5pm on the day of the heat.

Exhibit used must be entered and shown in its breed class on the day it is handled in the Junior Showmanship Competition. Judges for heats will be announced prior to commencement of judging each day. Judge for the finals may be a member of the Judging Panel and will be announced prior to the judging of the finals.

The finals for the Junior Showmanship Competition will occur after Group Specials and before Best In Show judging on General Specials Day.

Exhibits used for the final of the Junior Showmanship Competition are not required to be shown on the day.



Conditions, Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Entering and Competing

Policy regarding Melbourne Royal Dog Committee and Stewards



Judging Guidelines

Baby Puppy Classes

At the conclusion of breed judging in each ring, Best Baby Puppy of each breed will compete for Baby Puppy of the ring. Then the Best Baby Puppy of each ring will compete for Best Baby Puppy of the day. On General Specials day, only the Best Baby Puppy of each day will return to compete for Best Baby Puppy in Show.

ANKC Regulations

The ANKC has resolved that where a Royal Show only offers Best Puppy In Group/In Show and Best Exhibit In Group/In Show, then Group and Show placings shall apply. This type of judging does not necessarily produce the second, third and fourth best dogs in Group or Show, but rather the four best dogs in the ring from the Best Of Breed winners and, in the case of Best In Show, from the Group winners.



Conformation

General Specials Judging

Each Group will be judged in its entirety, in the same ring, in the order listed below. Judging will start with Best Exhibit in Group followed by Best Puppy in Group. Weather permitting, judging will take place outside on the Main Dog Judging Ring.

Judging will commence at 9am and the Groups will be judged in the following order: Group 2, Group 5, Group 3, Group 1, Group 4, Group 7, Group 6.

Sequence of Judging

As required by the ANKC Regulations the sequence of judging Best Exhibit in Group and Best Exhibit in Show awards shall be in the following order:

- 1. Best Exhibit in Group, placed in order 4th, 3rd, 2nd, 1st
- 2. Best Puppy In Group
- 3. Best Baby Puppy In Show
- 4. Best Exhibit In Show, placed in order 4th, 3rd, 2nd, 1st
- 5. Best Puppy In Show

Best of Breed

The judging of Best Of Breed and Runner Up to Best Of Breed will be conducted at the completion of judging each breed daily, in the normal way; however, the Runner-Up Best Of Breed shall not be required to return on General Specials Day. If you are to return on General Specials Day, you will be supplied with one (1) general admission ticket to return on the day.

Best Baby Puppy of the Day

The judging of Best Baby Puppy of the Day will be judged at the conclusion of all Breed judging on the day. Only Best Baby Puppy of the Day will be invited to return for judging of Best Baby Puppy in Show on General Specials Day. If you are to return on General Specials Day, you will be supplied with one (1) general admission ticket to return on the day.

Best Exhibit in Group

Only exhibits that have won Best Of Breed shall be eligible to compete for Best Exhibit In Group awards 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th subject to the provisions of ANKC Regulations. The judge shall select eight dogs from the Best of Breed winners. The balance of the Group is excused. The judge will then select 4th, 3rd, 2nd and 1st in Group in that order.

Puppy in Group

Only Best Puppy in Group award will be offered. Therefore, only puppies that have competed in Class 3 or Class 3A and have won Best Puppy of Breed are eligible to compete for Puppy In Group. The judge shall select four dogs from the puppy of breed winners. The balance of the puppies will be excused. From the four remaining, the judge will then select his/her Puppy in Group.

Best Baby Puppy in Show

Only Best Baby Puppy in Show award will be offered, therefore, only Best Baby Puppy on the Day winners are eligible to compete for Best Baby Puppy in Show.

Best Exhibit in Show

Only exhibits that have won Best Exhibit in Group shall be eligible to compete for Best Exhibit In Show awards 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th subject to the provisions of ANKC Regulations. The judge shall have the book marked in order of preference 1, 2, 3, 4. The microphone steward will announce, from the judge's book, the 4th BIS place-getter, which shall then proceed to the fourth peg and be presented with any awards. The same process is then followed for the 3rd place-getter, 2nd place-getter and Best in Show.

Best Puppy in Show

Only Best Puppy in Show award will be offered, therefore, only Best Puppy in Group winners are eligible to compete for Best Puppy In Show.

Breed Specialty Competitions

Breed Specialty Competitions are held in conjunction with the Melbourne Royal All Breeds Championship Show. Exhibitors wishing to enter their Breed Specialty are to contact their Breed Club directly for entry details.

Starting time will be at the conclusion of judging in the allocated Judge's ring, or soon thereafter.

Breed Clubs will be responsible for:

- Promotion of their own event;
- Management of entries and all aspects of administration;
- Benching allocations for dogs that are **not** entered in the Melbourne Royal Show.
- Production of all documentation required to be able to run their Specialty show on their allocated day. This includes the production of a catalogue, stewards sheets, allocation of exhibit numbers and all associated administration.
- Provide a ticket writer (for the documenting of results, creation of any certificates and marking the Catalogue etc.)
- Provision of all awards for the event and bringing them on the day;
- Option to hang one professional banner on the fence surrounding the allocated judging ring.

Melbourne Royal will be responsible for:

- Provision of VCA representative for the event;
- Provision of Melbourne Royal Stewards to run the event;
- Allocation of the officiating Judge. The Judge will be selected from the judging panel. The Judge will award trophies in the ring;
- Provision of place-markers for each judging ring.
