INFORMATION FOR DAIRY CATTLE EXHIBITORS

All Dairy breeds will be judged on Thursday 16 September, 2004, with the Interbreed Competitions on Saturday 18 September.

All breeds will be judged in The Weekly Times Undercover Judging Ring.

MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR AWARDS

Points will be accrued by the Steward during the judging of each breed, based on the allocation below.

Points are not accrued for Group Classes.

- (c) In the event of two or more Exhibitors securing an equal number of points, the Exhibitor gaining the greatest number of first prizes shall be the winner.
- (d) A special sash will be presented to the winner.

BEST PREPARED AND MAINTAINED TEAM AWARDS

In 2004, we will announce the Best Prepared and Maintained Team Awards in the judging ring immediately following the Interbreed.

- (a) Judging will take place in the Cattle Pavilions daily from Thursday 16th until Saturday 18th September.
- (b) The aim of the award is to encourage Exhibitors to display and maintain their teams in a manner befitting the dairy industry.
- (c) The Competition is open to Exhibitors with 2 head of cattle or over within each breed.
- (d) In the case of contract grooms who look after several breeds of cattle, they are to be regarded as a single Exhibitor within a breed.
- (e) There is no entry fee and all Exhibitors with the required number of cattle will be treated as competitors.
- (f) To maintain a desired standard of excellence throughout the entire Show, the Competition will provide first and runner-up prize cards for the winners.

The Competition shall be decided on the points awarded to each exhibitor from the maximum possible points in respect to the criteria listed below:

(a)	Groomed appearance of cattle	10 points
(b)	Contentment of cattle	5 points
(C)	Condition of bedding and economic use of same	10 points
(d)	Absence of excreta	5 points
(e)	General tidiness, inc. feeders and utensils	5 points
(f)	Promotion and Public Relations	5 points
(g)	Overall presentation	10 points
Total Possible Points 50 points		

The award of points of the Judges shall be final and not be called into question in any proceeding or in any manner whatsoever.

DAIRY INTERBREED

Conditions for judging all Interbreed Classes are as follows.

- (a) All Judges of the represented breeds will take part in the judging and will place the first five animals in order of their selection.
- (b) Each Judge shall only allocate points to Exhibits for those breeds he/she has not previously judged.
- (c) Judges shall refrain from conferring on the Exhibits before the winner is named or during judging.
- (d) Stewards appointed by the Society will assess the points on the basis of 8 points for first, 5 points for second, 3 points for third, 2 points for fourth, 1 point for fifth and the group or individual animal gaining the greatest number of points shall be the winner.
- (e) In the event of a tie it shall be decided on a count back.

REGULATIONS OF DAIRY CATTLE COMPETITION

101. The Regulations appearing in this Schedule form part of the General Regulations and conditions of entry to an Event at the Royal Melbourne Show. In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these Regulations, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations provide otherwise.

CLOSE OF NOMINATIONS AND ENTRIES

102. Nominations for the number of spaces (animals) and section(s) each Exhibitor will be exhibiting, must be made on the Official Nomination Form and be received by The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Limited by 5:30pm on Wednesday 7 July, 2004.

103. All associated fees, i.e.: Bedding, Locker, Clipping Frame Space, Truck parking fees must be paid at the time of nomination.

104. A completed Cattle Herd Health Status Declaration for Shows and Sales must accompany the Official Nomination Form.

105. Upon receipt of Nominations, Exhibitors will be forwarded an Official Entry Form, to be completed with the name/s of animals, registration numbers, copies of registration certificates and classes to be entered. The Official Entry Form must be returned to The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Limited by Wednesday 18 August, 2004.

106. Only Exhibitors who have made official Nominations by Wednesday 7 July, 2004 will be eligible to submit an Official Entry Form.

107. There will be no late Nomination or Official Entry Forms accepted under any circumstances. The onus is entirely on the Exhibitor to submit particulars on time. There will be no reminder from the Society.

108. Exhibitors may enter up to, and not exceeding, 150% of the spaces nominated.

109. Exhibitors must notify the RAS Cattle Section of their final team selection no later than close of business on 3 September 2004. Team selection can only be made from those officially entered and cannot exceed the number of spaces nominated. One space will be provided to each Exhibit.

110. There is no restriction on the number of Exhibits entered in each class.

ENTRY FEES

111. The pricing structure for dairy cattle in 2004 is as follows:

1 – 2 Exhibits entered:	\$78.50 each (inc. GST) for Non-members \$55.00 each (inc. GST) for Members
3 – 5 Exhibits entered:	\$62.90 each (inc. GST) for Non-members \$44.00 each (inc. GST) for Members
6-8 Exhibits entered:	\$55.00 each (inc. GST) for Non-members \$38.50 each (inc. GST) for Members
9 or more Exhibits entered:	\$47.20 each (inc. GST) for Non-members \$33.00 each (inc. GST) for Members

FEED LOCKERS

112. In accordance with other cattle Exhibitors, a fee of \$33.00 (GST inc.) will now apply to each Feed Locker, payable at the time of Nominations. Due to limited Feed Lockers, we reserve the right to limit allocation in an effort to accommodate all Exhibitors.

TRUCK PARKING

113. Parking for Trucks and Floats is available in the VRC Racecourse. Apply by completing the relevant section on the Nomination Form, and forward the fee with the competition entry fee.

114. Truck Parking fees for 2004 will be:

If paid with entries:

\$15.00 (inc. GST) per day \$22.00 (inc. GST) per day \$66.00 (inc. GST) full show \$85.00 (inc. GST) full show

115. There is to be no camping in the VRC Truck Park under any circumstances.

116. Any vehicle, including trucks, stock transports, trailers, and horse floats, located on the Showgrounds, or any area leased by the Society, shall be at the sole risk of the owner. The Society accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage, including loss or damage caused by negligence of the Society, it's officers, employee's, or agents to any vehicle, or the contents of any vehicle, located on the Society's property or any area leased by the Society.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS

117. Dairy cattle Exhibits can arrive from 10:00am Sunday, 12 September 2004, however all Exhibits must be on the Showgrounds no later than 4:00pm Tuesday 14 September 2004. Access times for these days, inclusive of Monday 13 September, will be from 10:00am until 4:00pm.

118. All dairy cattle Exhibits will depart from 6:00pm on Saturday 18 September.

119. Priority may be given to those that have considerable distance to travel.

ELIGIBILITY OF EXHIBITS

120. An animal shall not be admitted to the Showgrounds, unless it is entered for exhibition.

121. Bull Classes are not offered at the Royal Melbourne Show. Dairy breed bulls shall not be admitted to the Showgrounds.

STANDARD OF EXHIBITS AND INSPECTIONS

122. The standard of Exhibits shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations pertaining to the Breed Standards as accepted by the relevant Breed Society and as approved by the Society.

123. Every animal exhibited in the Dairy Cattle section at the Royal Melbourne Show will be subject to an inspection, carried out by an Inspector appointed by the Society.

124. Each Breed Society or Association shall put forward nominations for these appointments for their breed, and these nominations will be considered by the Society.

125. Exhibitors are required to have their stock attended and clean in readiness for inspection by not later than 8:00am on the relevant day. The Inspector(s) shall on the relevant day make every effort to submit their report by 1:00pm to the Society.

126. No Exhibitor shall be permitted to exhibit any cattle bearing marking brands or tattoos not consistent with those shown on the relevant entry form or Breed Society records.

127. Exhibitors are strongly advised to inspect marking brands and tattoos prior to lodging entry forms and before departure for the show.

128. Without prejudice to any other applicable rules, if the relevant Inspector determines that any animal entered for exhibition:

(a) is not true to type; or

(b) is not of sufficient merit as to be worthy of exhibit in the class or classes for which it is entered; or

(c) has not been adequately prepared for the Show; or

(d) bears any marking brand or tattoo inconsistent with the markings brand or tattoo disclosed in the relevant entry form or Breed Society Records or whose tattoo is not clearly legible; or

(e) is in breach of the rules under the heading "Tampering of Exhibits";

then such animal shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show

129. Any animal infected by ringworm or warts shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show. The Inspectors shall report any animal which they believe to be infected by ringworm or warts and the Society's Veterinary Surgeon shall inspect such animal for the purpose of determining whether the animal is so infected.

130. Without prejudice to the General Regulations, the determinations of the Inspectors or of the Veterinary Surgeons on any matter shall be subject only to appeal to the Chief Stewards or Assistant Chief Stewards in the Cattle Section who shall make such determinations and directions as they deem appropriate. Such appeal shall be accompanied with a deposit of \$50 which may be forfeited to the Society if in the sole opinion of the Chief Steward the appeal is unfounded, frivolous or vexatious.

131. The Inspectors, Veterinary Surgeons, Chief Stewards, or their assistants shall not be required to furnish to the Exhibitor any reasons for their determinations or directions nor to give the Exhibitor any right to be heard on any matter in question.

132. Notwithstanding any other provision in the regulations, where the Society determines that any animal entered in the Cattle Sections has received hormones, then such animal shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show.

Any determination made by the Society pursuant to this regulation shall be final.

133. The Society may make or cause to be made, at any time during the period of exhibition, an inspection or any test of an Exhibit to determine whether a breach of the regulations under the heading of Standard of Exhibits and Inspections has occurred. If, as a result of a breach of any of these regulations, an animal is deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show, the Society may by notice to the Exhibitor require the animal be forthwith removed from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor, upon receipt of such notice, shall forthwith remove such animal and, failing such removal by him within the time prescribed by the Society, the Society may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the Society.

Any determination made by the Society pursuant to this regulation shall be final.

134. If an award has been made to an Exhibit deemed to be ineligible under these regulations, any prize awarded will be forfeited and, subject to General Regulation 10.5. Exhibits in the next order may be promoted to that prize.

TAMPERING OF EXHIBITS

135. Notwithstanding General Regulation 7.4, no Exhibitor shall be permitted to exhibit any cattle which, in the opinion of the Society, displays evidence of being tampered with or, in the definition of the class in which it is entered, an animal entered for exhibition or competition is not presented in its natural conformation and has no preparation other than normal feeding and fitting with the exception of normal dressing of hair, hoofs and horns.

136. The following practices are strictly prohibited:

(a) An operation or any kind of surgery materially altering the structure or the natural conformation of any part of the animal's body.

(b) The infusion or injection of any drugs or any other substance or the insertion of any object into the teats, blood vessels, muscles or under the skin of any animal to restrict the flow of milk or alter its natural physical attributes.

(c) The setting of the teats of an animal with any form of glue or other setting substance or any other action which alters the natural teat placement of an animal.

Evidence of such practices renders an Exhibit liable to instant disqualification and the Exhibitor or his/her agent liable to a suspension ranging from 5 years to lifetime.

137. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to ensure the animal is not subject to prohibited practices, prior to and whilst on the Showgrounds.

138. The Society may make or cause to be made, any test of any Exhibit to determine whether any drug or other substance has been administered to the Exhibit and may take possession of any such Exhibit for any of the aforesaid purposes and detain such Exhibit for such period as the Society deems necessary.

Procedures for the testing of prohibited substances may include random tests on Exhibits.

Should a positive test to a prohibited substance or practice result, any costs associated with testing will be borne by the Exhibitor.

TINTING AND/OR COLOURING OF COAT

139. Should the Society or appointed Breed Inspector, be of the opinion that the coat of any Exhibit has been tinted and/or coloured in any way, then such an animal shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show.

HEALTH DECLARATION

140. All exhibits must be declared free of T.B., Brucellosis, Johne's Disease and other notifiable diseases.

141. As a condition of entry, all cattle exhibitors are to provide a fully correct Cattle Herd Health Status Declaration completed and signed at time of entry by:

(a) The exhibitor or agent of the exhibitor, and

(b) a Government Veterinary Officer/Stock Inspector also acting as a qualified witness.

142. Cattle entered from any State or Territory of the Commonwealth of Australia are eligible for entry provided that they originate from herds or properties that are:

a) not known or suspected to have had Johne's disease; or

(b) currently participating in the National Johne's Disease Market Assurance Program (Cattle MAP) or are from a Protected or Free Zone (currently Western Australia, Northern Territory, Queensland and some of New South Wales); or

(c) under strict regulatory control and;

 (i) have been enrolled in official, audited test and control programs for a minimum of 2 years; and

(ii) at least 2 consecutive annual whole herd tests have been conducted with a reactor rate not exceeding 1.5% at the latest herd test; and

(iii) the cattle to be exhibited, or their dams, have been tested with negative results as part of at least the last 2 annual herd tests; and

(iv) the cattle to be exhibited are not officially listed as "at risk" cattle for the particular herd; and

(v) the cattle to be exhibited have been tested negative within 3 months of entry to the Show.

Exhibitors may also need additional certification to move between Zones or between States. Please check with the local Veterinary authority.

143. Cattle entered must not be subject to quarantine or restriction with respect to any other notifiable disease.

144. All Exhibitors must provide the tail tag number for the property/properties where the cattle originate from.

REGISTRATION

145. Legible copies of registration papers must be forwarded to the Society at the time of submitting entries.

146. No pending registrations will be accepted.

147. Registration papers forwarded by facsimile transmission will not be accepted.

148. All exhibits must be entered in the name of the registered owner.

NECK NUMBERS

- 149. Neck numbers corresponding to the Exhibit numbers in the catalogue must be worn by the Exhibits when entering the ring to appear before the Judge or when otherwise required.
- 150. Neck numbers must be obtained by the Exhibitor from the Cattle Superintendent's Office.

ABSENCE OF EXHIBIT

- 151. Notwithstanding Regulations 5.1 and 5.2 Exhibitors may withdraw exhibits provided that written notification is given to the Society by 4:00pm, Friday, 20th August, 2004. \$20 of the Bedding fee will be refunded for each head of cattle withdrawn in writing by this time.
- 152. Where any Exhibitor fails to show any exhibit entered in the show, and it has not been withdrawn in writing by 4:00pm Friday, 20th August, the Exhibitor will be required to pay a fine of \$50 per exhibit not shown, unless the failure to exhibit is due to one of the reasons specified in General Regulation 5.1 and such reason is accepted by the Society. Any such late notification of withdrawal must be in writing, and delivered to the Cattle Superintendent's Office on the day of arrival.
- 153. If an Exhibitor fails to show any Exhibit entered in the Show without having given notice in accordance with these Regulations, that Exhibitor may be prohibited from showing any exhibit in any section of the Show.

HOURS OF OPENING OF PAVILIONS AND CLEANING

- 154. All cattle pavilions will be opened to the public from 10:00am to 9:00pm daily, unless closed by the Cattle Manager or Society staff.
- 155. Exhibitors shall, to the satisfaction of the Cattle Manager;
- (a) Keep each stall allotted to them and their stock in a clean and proper condition throughout the Show.
- (b) Clean out their stalls each day, no later than the times specified in circular advice to Exhibitors.
- (c) Clean their area regularly. Refuse must be deposited in the manure bins provided.
- (d) Manure must not be deposited in the alleyways or general purpose rubbish bins.
- (e) General purpose rubbish must not be deposited in manure bins.
- (f) To assist in the transfer of manure to the bins provided, please bring own cleaning tools
- (g) Stock must not be left unattended outside pavilions at any time.
- 156. Dairy Cattle must not be rugged between the hours of 10:00am and 6:30pm.

BEDDING

- 157. The following regulations apply to bedding costs and bedding materials.
- (a) Sawdust will be the only bedding for dairy cattle on the Showgrounds.
- (b) Exhibitors are required to pay a bedding fee at the time of submitting official Nomination Forms.
- (c) If bedding boards are required, Exhibitors are to supply their own.
- (d) Use of bedding straw is not permitted in any cattle pavilions.

SAWDUST BEDDING FOR CATTLE - PRINCIPLES FOR GOOD MANAGEMENT

- 158. To achieve the best results from bedding cattle on sawdust, the following system of management is recommended:
- (a) Pick up manure at every opportunity.
- (b) Place hay in feeders and avoid feeding excessive amounts.
- (c) Avoid water spillage in stalls.
- (d) Regularly smooth out the bed with the aim of assisting drying.
- (e) Consider using rubber matting for front half of bed.
- (f) Do not dig out the wet patches.
- (g) Do not disturb the bedding base.
- (h) Keep the top of the bed loose.
- (i) 100mm borders are an advantage in managing the bed.

Experience has shown that properly managed bed will last a full Show with little need for top up bedding, particularly with some classes of livestock.

FEED LOCKERS AND FODDER

- 159. Exhibitors are not permitted to stack feed in the Cattle Pavilions except on the fodder lofts or in their own feed sheds.
- 160. Stock requisites can be obtained from the Fodder Merchant who will be situated on the Showgrounds.

CLIPPING OF EXHIBITS

- 161. A limited number of clipping frame spaces will be available, provided an application for space and a \$33.00 fee (inc. GST) accompanies the official Nomination Form.
- 162. Each Exhibitor is restricted to one clipping frame only.
- 163. All clipping frames must have secure flooring and face the front of the stall only.

164. Clipping frames must only be kept in their designated area. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in automatic removal of the clipping frame.

SECURITY OF ANIMALS

- 165. All Exhibits must be provided with effective halters and be thoroughly broken to lead
- 166. All calves must be securely tethered at all times.
- 167. Each Exhibitor shall ensure that each of their Exhibits is securely tethered in its stall.
- 168. All Exhibitors shall ensure that their Exhibits are not left unattended
- 169. If in its absolute discretion the Society determines any Exhibit or Exhibits of stock to be dangerous for any reason whatsoever, the Society may by notice to the Exhibitor require the animal or animals concerned to be forthwith removed from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor upon receipt of such notice, shall forthwith remove such animal and failing such removal by the Exhibitor within the time prescribed by the Society, the Society may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the Society.

GRAND PARADES

170. Exhibitors are required to participate in a Grand Parade under the following formula:

1-3 head exhibited 1 head paraded 4-6 head exhibited 2 head paraded over 6 head exhibited 3 head paraded

171. All prize-winning cattle must be taken on Grand Parade in accordance with the printed programme after judging day. No ribbons will be permitted on Exhibits except those won during the Show.

172. Leather halters must be worn by all exhibits in Grand Parades.

SALES AND NOTICES

173. Exhibitors are permitted to display cards over the stalls stating that an animal is for sale provided such cards do not exceed 30cm x 25cm in size. No other advertisements or notices (except by permission of the Society) are permitted on or in any stalls or buildings.

174. A Commission of 1.25% shall be paid to the Society in respect of all stock sold on the Showgrounds.

STUD IDENTIFICATION NOTICE

175. Each Exhibitor is permitted to display one sign 600mm x 1200mm in size provided that such sign carries only the stud name, address, telephone number, facsimile number and e-mail address.

JUDGING

- 176. The following regulations shall be read subject to General Regulations 10.1 to 10.6 and 11.1 to 11.7 of the General Regulations.
- (a) Exhibits shall be present at the appropriate judging ring and ready to enter the judging ring at the time specified in the Timetable for the event to take place. Exhibits shall enter the judging ring immediately upon request by the appropriate Steward.
- (b) Persons in charge of Exhibits must in no circumstances leave their Exhibits unattended at or in the judging ring.
- (c) Persons in charge of Exhibits at or in the judging ring shall not address the Judge unless authorised by the Chief Steward or the Judge himself.
- (d) Judges shall have the right to order that a cow be milked dry before awarding a prize.
- (e) All attendants leading stock in the judging ring or on Grand Parade shall wear uniform white coats or approved breed uniform. Such white coat or uniform must in no way show any insignia or any descriptive markings indicating the Exhibitor's name and/or stud name or prefix.

FIRE REGULATIONS

- 177. Persons who breach General Regulations 13.1 to 13.3 (Fire Regulations) may be required by notice from the Society to forthwith remove themselves and their Exhibits from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor and Exhibits concerned may be prohibited from entry to one or more future Shows. The determination of the Society in this regard shall be final and not be called into question in any manner or in any proceedings whatsoever.
- 178. An Exhibitor, upon receipt of a notice pursuant to this Regulation, shall forthwith remove all his Exhibits and failing such removal by the Exhibitor within the time prescribed by the Society, the Society may remove or cause to be removed all the animals concerned and all costs and expenses of such removal shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the Society.
- 179. Smoking is at all times prohibited in the pavilions and in the Feed Lockers.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

180. The prize money advice slip issued by the Society will denote each cash prize won by either class number or special prize number viz, (S032)

SPECIAL PRIZES

181. The Society reserves the right to increase, alter or delete special prizes or prize money.

PRIZE RIBBONS

182. Subject to Regulations, ribbons may be awarded throughout the dairy cattle classes for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places only.

DAIRY COMPLEX

- 183. The Society has provided an 8 unit Flat shed Dairy Complex to be situated behind the Fodder Shed. All cows will be required to be milked in this complex except for:
- (a) Sick Animals
- (b) Special circumstances approved by the Dairy Cattle Committee.
- 184. The Complex will be open for milking from Sunday, 12 September 2004.
- 185. Dairy Complex Rules and Regulations are as follows:
- (a) No use of portable milking machines will be allowed, except at the discretion of the Dairy Supervisor.
- (b) Dairy Managers will co-ordinate all operations of the Dairy Complex.
- (c) Breed Representatives will determine the milking roster which will be strictly adhered to.
- (d) Individual cows will be identified by Catalogue Number.
- (e) All cows milked MUST be leg banded. PROBLEM milk cows MUST have RED leg bands on and will be milked last. All other cows MUST have GREEN numbered leg bands on. The numbers and bands will be allocated by the Dairy Supervisor.
- (f) Cows will be individually sampled every milking and tested for components, cell count and antibiotic residues.
- (g) Severe penalties will be enforced for contamination of bulk milk.
- (h) All cow's teats are to be washed before milking and dipped/sprayed after milking. Cups should be reversed flushed after the milking of mastitic cows and before the next cow is milked on those cups.
- (i) Rugs must be off all cattle at all milkings.
- (j) All people working in the Dairy must be properly attired.
- (k) Judging Day Dairy will close at 7.00 am and re-open at 9.00 am or at the discretion of the Dairy Supervisor.
- Disputes will be referred to the Dairy Supervisor and will be resolved by the Dairy Cattle Committee.
- (m) The consumption of alcohol and smoking is banned within the confines of the Dairy.

COSTS AND DISPOSAL OF CONTAMINATED MILK

- 186. As this complex is a registered Dairy, the same conditions applicable to on farm Dairies will apply: i.e. Any exhibitors who supply milk that contaminates a bulk tanker or a tanker load of milk will be held financially responsible for:
- (a) The cost of collection and transport of the milk to the processing factory, including a replacement load of market milk.
- (b) Value of the milk lost due to contamination.
- (c) Cost of disposing of the contaminated milk.

Disposal costs will vary and producers will be given the option of disposing of the milk on their own properties.

187. Contaminated milk is considered to be any milk containing antibiotic, colostrum, blood or strong taint or smell.

AYRSHIRE

Judging will be in catalogue order.

Cattle entered in this section must be registered in the Ayrshire Herd Book of Australia, the Herd Book of the Australian Ayrshire Breeders' Association Inc. or in an approved Ayrshire Herd Book outside the Commonwealth.

Females recorded in APPENDICES A and B of an Ayrshire Herd Book will be eligible to compete in this section.

For particulars of registration in the Ayrshire Herd Book of Australia, apply to the Secretary, Ayrshire Australia Ltd., P.O.
