QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS

1. Any Gymkhana affiliated with the Equestrian Federation of Australia (Victorian Branch Inc.) and each Country Show Society affiliated with the Victorian Agricultural Societies Association is invited to co-operate in qualifying competitions for these trophies, by providing annually riding competitions for competitors 12 YEARS AND UNDER 15 YEARS OF AGE on the day of its show.
2. Each Society conducting qualifying competitions is required to notify the R.A.S.V. of the names and addresses of the winners and "runners-up", so that if it is found that, for any reason, the winners were ineligible, an opportunity may be given to the "runners-up" to compete in the Championship Competitions.
3. Such competitions to be named "The Good Hands Qualifying Riding Competitions", and the R.A.S.V. to provide suitable certificates for presentation to the winners.

4. The holder of an R.A.S.V. Qualifying Certificate, won in the same year, shall not be eligible to compete.

5. (a) The competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability - mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account, but special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony.

(b) Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre, the mouthpiece must be smooth and of the one metal, with or without a cavesson noseband. A gear check may take place. Please note: straight bar snaffle and drop nosebands are not allowed.

CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITION

6. Only holders of 2003 qualifying certificates will be eligible to compete for the Challenge Trophies at The 2003 Royal Melbourne Show. No entry fee will be charged.

7. (a) The Championship Competition shall be judged on the same basis as the qualifying competitions, but the Judge, before finally making his or her award, shall require his or her six finalists to execute a figure 8 at a canter, ride away from the Judge, return at a slow canter, stop at the Judge's signal and back.

(b) Equipment used must be as for the Qualifying Competition as specified in 5 (b) above.

8. The names of the winners will be engraved on the Challenge Trophies.

9. Suitably inscribed Championship Sashes will be presented to each successive winner of the challenge Trophies.

10. The winners of the Challenge Trophies will be eligible to compete in future years, subject to age.

11. The R.A.S.V. may, at its discretion, vary the conditions governing the qualifying and Championship Competitions.

12. All entries must be lodged with the Society by 5.30 p.m. on Thursday, September 4, 2003.

The Classes in this Section are arranged in groups to facilitate the various gradings of horses, types of events and age of riders.

In this Section "Exhibit" includes Pony, Galloway and Horse as appropriate.

FOR EXHIBITS ENTERED IN JUMPING COMPETITIONS CONDUCTED UNDER F.E.I. RULES, PARTICULARS OF PERFORMANCE MUST BE FURNISHED ON THE APPROPRIATE FORM, EXTRA COPIES OF WHICH ARE AVAILABLE FROM THIS OFFICE ON REQUEST. THE PERFORMANCE CARD (OR PREFERABLY A PHOTOSTAT OF SAME) MUST BE FORWARDED WITH THE NOMINATION FORM. INCOMPLETE ENTRY FORMS WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY REJECTED WITHOUT RIGHT OF APPEAL.

After the close of nominations, the Society will determine which entries will be accepted and for which animals accommodation will be provided. All entrants will be notified of the Society's decision. **The nomination fee for unaccepted entries will not be refunded.**

Riders may NOT ride more than two horses in any event.

METHOD OF ENTRY:

Nominations shall be accompanied by a fee of \$24.20 (incl. GST) per nomination per Group (which is not refundable).

Special classes nomination fee is \$6.60 (incl. GST) per class, World Cup excepted.

Successful nominations will be notified by mid July and will be subject to an entry fee payable by 28th July, 2003. Appeals for any unsuccessful nominations must be in writing and received by Competition Administration, RASV Limited, by the date specified on the rejection letter. **NO TELEPHONE OR FAXED APPEALS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** A fee of \$25 per exhibit **MUST** accompany each appeal.

For details of entry for World Cup Qualifying Round, see Class 327.

Entries for Special Events 331 & 332 do not necessarily have to be entered or accepted for Groups A, B, C or D. **However, late entries will be accepted for those combinations competing in Groups A, B, C or D. Late entries will be accepted up until 9am the day prior to the event.**

The draw will be available by 5pm on the day prior to the event.

A maximum of 25 horses will be accepted for Group A, Group B and Group C. The Society reserves the right to reject or transfer any entry.

Owners nominating for Group D (for junior riders) should indicate Group D in the appropriate place on the entry form.

A person may compete as a Junior from the beginning of the year in which they reach the age of 12 till the end of the year in which they reach the age of 18.

Juniors may nominate.

All exhibits entered in Groups A, B, C & D in this Section must be registered in the Register of Equestrian Federation of Australia. For particulars of registration apply to the Equestrian Federation of Australia in the State concerned.

Riders of exhibits in Groups A, B and C must be financial members of the Equestrian Federation of Australia.

Riders of exhibits in Group D must be Junior Members of the Equestrian Federation of Australia.

PLEASE NOTE: Where the owner and rider are different any prizemoney will be awarded to the registered owner.

The Council of the Society shall appoint a Ground Jury and a Jury of Appeal in accordance with F.E.I. regulations.

The Steward in charge has been authorised to scratch any horse if it is not ready to compete at the time directed by the stewards.

Owners desirous of scratching their exhibits for any event must do so with the Horse Superintendent at least two hours before the advertised time of starting. Failure to comply with this regulation will render exhibitors liable to a penalty of \$10 for the first offence and \$30 for second or later offences.

Owners entering their exhibits do so entirely at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society, its Council officers, officials or members in any respect whatsoever, other than the liability for refund of entry fees in the event of abandonment of any competition.

All events to be run over course and obstacles as the Society may decide.

IN ALL EVENTS OVER OBSTACLES OF ANY DESCRIPTION, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, RIDERS MUST BE IN THE 16TH YEAR OF THEIR BIRTH DATE.

DRESS

Ladies (18 and over)

In jumping competitions excepting Group D, ladies must wear either:

Approved safety helmet, black or dark coat, stock or collar and tie, breeches and black top boots; or

Hunting costume and approved safety helmet.

Gentlemen (15 years and over)

In jumping competitions excepting Group D, gentlemen must wear:

Approved safety helmet; and

Hunting livery of a recognised hunt club;

Black coat with stock, white breeches, black top boots; or

Riding coat with tie, fawn breeches, black or tan top boots.

Group D

Riders must wear approved safety helmet, riding coat, tie, jodhpurs, black or tan boots (riders over 12 years allowed to wear top boots).

SPURS OTHER THAN DUMMY SPURS NOT EXCEEDING 3/4" IN LENGTH ARE PROHIBITED.

DEFINITION OF JUMPING ARENA

The Jumping Arena will, when practicable, be entirely enclosed, but if not, will be clearly marked with flags or some other easily recognised indicator. At all times the Trotting Track will be taken as off the Jumping Arena. It will be the responsibility of all competitors to acquaint themselves with the extent of the arena and its markings before competing.

THE SOCIETY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INTRODUCE A STANDARD AT ANY TIME.

CRUELTY TO EXHIBITS is forbidden either in the arena, exercise area or elsewhere. A competitor found guilty of committing a definite act of cruelty will be disallowed from taking part in any further competitions at the show where the offence was committed. The decision rests with the Jury and no appeal will be considered.
