- 4. Upon receipt of Nominations, exhibitors will be forwarded an Official Entry Form, to be completed with the name/s of animals, registration numbers, copy of Registration Certificate and Classes to be entered. The Official Entry Form must be returned to the Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Limited by 5.30 pm Friday, 30th August, 2002. \$20 per head of the bedding fee will be refundable for those animals withdrawn by 30th August, 2002.
- 5. PLEASE NOTE: Pending registrations and facsimiles will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 6. Only exhibitors who have made Official Nominations by 30th July, will be eligible to submit an Official Entry Form.
- 7. There will be NO late entries or Nominations accepted under ANY circumstances.
- 8. Exhibitors may enter up to and not exceeding 150% of the spaces booked.
- Exhibitors must notify the Cattle Section of their final team selection no later than
 close of business on 12th September 2002. Please keep in mind that the team
 selection can only be made from those officially entered and cannot exceed the
 number of spaces booked.

Exhibitors are advised that in addition to reading the following conditions, they should carefully peruse the Schedule of Classes, Prizes and Rules Applicable to Beef and Dairy Cattle Classes and the General Regulations.

"IN MILK" CLASSES

Cows which fail to yield 2 kg. or more of milk in the 24 hours immediately preceding judging or in a period of 24 hours stipulated by the Chief Steward or his nominee subsequent to judging, shall be deemed to be "dry" by the Chief Steward or his nominee and shall not be eligible for exhibition in the "In Milk" Classes.

PRIZE CARDS

Cards will be issued up to sixth place in all ordinary classes.

PRIZE RIBBONS

Ribbons may be awarded throughout the Dairy Sections in accordance with the following table.

Up to 9 exhibits - 4 ribbons 10 or more exhibits - 6 ribbons

PRODUCTION CLASSES - CONDITIONS

The production figures used in judging will be the weight of butterfat and protein (expressed in kilograms) and volume of milk (expressed in litres) from the lactation begun 1st September, 2000, or later to production as at 1st September, 2002 with a maximum limit of 305 days.

Certificates of Production must be from recognised **Recording Facilities**, and entered animals clearly identified.

Such certificates **MUST** accompany the entry form OR be forwarded to the Society's Office by Friday, 30th August, 2002, for exhibits where applicable.

All records will be verified prior to commencement of the Show, with the appropriate Recording Facility.

IF CERTIFICATES ARE NOT RECEIVED BY FRIDAY, 30th AUGUST, 2002 THE ENTRIES SO AFFECTED WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR PRODUCTION PRIZES.

SPECIAL PRODUCTION PRIZES AND CLASSES

Special Type and Production Prizes are presented in female classes 3 years old and over, in milk and dry, in each Dairy Breed Section.

Only those females placed first, second or third in the Type judging of their class will be eligible. A first prize winner will receive ten (10) points and a second prize winner will receive five (5) points in recognition of their award received in the Type judging. These points will be added to their Production figure and the winner will be the cow with the highest total score.

There is no entry fee required to compete for these prizes but the Conditions for Production Classes (see above) must be fulfilled.

A Special Prize presented by **STOCK AND LAND** and a green Rosette will be awarded to the winning female from amongst the winners of the Special Type and Production Prizes in the specified classes in each breed. Prize \$100 and \$150 Advertising Voucher.

First prize will be awarded to the female having the highest Production and Type Judging Score. The calculated Production figure for this competition will be announced for each cow.

In the event of a tie, the female with the highest Production figure will be the winner. The winning cow will automatically be eligible for the Stock and Land Interbreed Type and Production Class.

INTERBREED COMPETITIONS

Judging will be held in the "Weekly Times" judging ring on Saturday 21st September, 2002, unless otherwise stated.

CONDITIONS FOR JUDGING ALL INTERBREED CLASSES

Should any breed fail to provide the required number of animals, that breed of exhibit cannot take part in the Competition.

All judges of the represented breeds will take part in the judging and will place the first five animals in order of their selection.

Each judge shall only allocate points to animals other than his own breed (the breed he has judged).

Judges shall refrain from conferring on the exhibits before the winner is named or during judging.

Stewards appointed by the Society will assess the points on the basis of 8 points for first, 5 points for second, 3 points for third, 2 points for fourth, 1 point for fifth and the group or individual animal gaining the greatest number of points shall be the winner. In the event of a tie it shall be decided on a count back.

DAIRY COMPLEX

The Society has provided an 8 unit Flat shed Dairy Complex to be situated behind the Fodder Shed.

All cows will be required to be milked in this complex except for:

- 1. Sick Animals
- 2. Special circumstances approved by the Dairy Cattle Committee.

The Complex will be open for milking from Monday, 16th September.

DAIRY COMPLEX RULES & REGULATIONS

- No use of portable milking machines will be allowed, except at the discretion of the Dairy Supervisor.
- 2 Dairy Managers will co-ordinate all operations of the Dairy Complex.
- 3. Shed Marshalls will determine the milking roster which will be strictly adhered
- 4 Individual cows will be identified by RASV Catalogue Number.
- 5. All cows milked **MUST** be leg banded. **PROBLEM** milk cows **MUST** have **RED** leg bands on and will be milked last. All other cows **MUST** have **GREEN** numbered leg bands on. The numbers and bands will be allocated by the Dairy Supervisor.
- Cows will be individually sampled every milking and tested for components, cell count and antibiotic residues.
- 7. Severe penalties will be enforced for contamination of bulk milk.
- 8. All cow's teats are to be washed before milking and dipped/sprayed after milking. Cups should be reversed flushed after the milking of mastitic cows and before the next cow is milked on those cups.
- 9. Rugs must be off all cattle at all milkings.
- 10. DRESS All people working in the Dairy must be properly attired.
- 11. Judging Day Dairy will close at 7.00 am and re-open at 9.00 am or at the discretion of the Dairy Supervisor.
- 12. Disputes will be referred to the Dairy Supervisior and will be resolved by the Dairy Cattle Committee.
- 13. The consumption of alcohol and smoking is banned within the confines of the Dairy.

COSTS AND DISPOSAL OF CONTAMINATED MILK

As this complex is a registered Dairy, the same conditions applicable to on farm Dairies will apply: i.e. Any exhibitors who supply milk that contaminates a bulk tanker or a tanker load of milk will be held financially responsible for:

- (i) The cost of collection and transport of the milk to the processing factory, including a replacement load of market milk.
- (ii) Value of the milk lost due to contamination
- (iii) Cost of disposing of the contaminated milk.

Disposal costs will vary and producers will be given the option of disposing of the milk on their own properties. Contaminated milk is considered to be any milk containing antibiotic, colostrum, blood or strong taint or smell.
