RICH FRUIT CAKE : 250g each sultanas, seeded raisins (chopped), currants, 125g mixed peel (chopped), 90g red glace cherries (chopped), 90g blanched almonds (chopped), 1/3 cup sherry or brandy, 250g plain flour, 60g self raising flour, 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg, 1/2 teaspoon each ground ginger and ground cloves, 250g butter, 250g soft brown sugar, 1/2 teaspoon each almond essence and vanilla essence, 1/2 teaspoon lemon essence or finely grated lemon rind, 4 large eggs.

METHOD: Mix together all fruits and nuts and sprinkle with sherry or brandy. Cover and leave for at least 1 hour, but preferably overnight. Sift together the flours and spices. Cream together the butter and sugar with the essences. Add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition, then alternately add the fruit and flour mixtures. Mix thoroughly. The mixture should be stiff enough to support a wooden spoon. Place the mixture into a prepared square tin with sharp corners, no larger than 20cm and bake in a slow oven for approximately 3 1/2 to 4 hours or until cooked when tested. Allow the cake to cool in the tin.

NOTE: To ensure uniformity, and depending upon the size, it is suggested the raisins be snipped into 2 or 3 pieces; cherries into 4 - 6 pieces and almonds crosswise into 3 - 4 pieces.
