EXPLANATION

WHEREAS The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Ltd has agreed to effect a Public Liability insurance for certain Animal Exhibitors at the

Insured Activities: All activities undertaken whilst within and from the confines of the event venue consistent with the Insured's livestock exhibit activity

including setting up and removal

Description of Cover: Insurance in respect of the Insured Party's liability to pay costs and compensation in respect of loss of or damage to third party property

and death of or injury to third party persons caused by and arising out of the Insured activities, all subject to the RASV's policy terms,

conditions, exclusions and warranties, etc.

Amount of Cover: \$10,000,000 any one occurrence

Peductible: \$10,000 any one occurrence

Geographic Limits: At and from the event venue

Claims Payable: Worldwide excluding claims made USA and Canada Insurer(s): Primary - \$10,000,000 Lloyds of London

IMPORTANT CONDITIONS

- 1. The Insured Party must exercise reasonable care to maintain all premises, fittings and plant in sound condition.
- 2. The Insured Party must take all reasonable precautions to prevent injury and damage to persons and property.
- 3. The Insured Party must give immediate notice of an incident which may give rise to a claim or of receipt of advice of a claim.
- 4. The Insured Party must not make any admission, offer or promise in connection with any claim and must not any time admit liability.
- 5. The Insured Party must make themselves aware of and comply with the following Notices:-
- (a) **Duty of Disclosure:** Before you enter into a contract of General insurance with an insurer, you have a duty, under the Insurance Contracts Act 1984 as amended, to disclose to the insurer every matter that you know, or could reasonably be expected to know, is relevant to the insurer's decision whether to accept the risk of the insurance and, if so, on what terms.

You have the same duty to disclose these matters to the insurer before you renew, extend, vary or reinstate a contract of General insurance.

Your duty however, does not require disclosure of matter:

- * that diminishes the risk to be undertaken by the insurer
- * that is of common knowledge
- * that your insurer knows or, in the ordinary course of his business, ought to know.

Non-Disclosure: If you fail to comply with your duty of disclosure, the insurer may be entitled to reduce his liability under the contract in respect of a claim or may cancel the contract.

If your non-disclosure is fraudulent, the insurer may also have the option of avoiding the contract from its beginning.

- (b) Average Provision: The insurer will pay legal expenses in addition to the sum insured, if however, the total amount of the loss (less legal expenses) ultimately paid to the claimant(s) exceeds the sum insured then insurers will only pay (in addition to the sum insured) that proportion of the legal expenses as the sum insured bears to the loss.
- (c) Third Party Interests: This policy will only provide cover for your interest and does not cover the interests of any third party (e.g. financiers, lessors, etc) unless the interests of the third party are noted in the policy.
- (d) Waiver of Insurer's Rights: You must not enter into any agreement without the written authority of the insurer whereby any of their rights to which they become entitled as your insurer after settling or agreeing to settle a claim are prejudiced or limited in any way otherwise all benefit under the policy will be forfeited.

RASV is not providing financial product advice, has not considered the particular needs of the Insured party and no statement is intended to influence a person or persons making a decision in relation to any insurance cover. IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

LOCATION

In 2013, the Alpaca Competition will be conducted in the Nicholas Pavilion, Building 18.

TIMETABLE

The Alpaca timetable for the 2013 Show will be different from the timetable used in previous years. The timetable is listed opposite, with notable changes outlined below.

 Alpaca judging will take place over Saturday 6 July – Sunday 7 July 2013.

ENTRY FEES

Entry Fee information can be found in the Regulations for the Alpaca Competition. All Entry Fees incorporate bedding costs.

ENTRIES

Entries for Progeny classes will be taken on the day of judging only and do not require additional entry fees.

Exhibitors are asked to take the following action:

- Do not enter animals which you doubt you will decide to bring to the show;
- Talk to one or more other breeders with whom you would be prepared to share pens. In particular, take biosecurity issues into account. Complete the Penning Information Form accompanying this Schedule;
- On the Penning Information Form, record the number of 2.1m x 2.1m pens which you consider your entries will need. As a guide, a single pen may take up to 3 juniors and a double up to 7 juniors;
- Be prepared to nominate animals which you will withdraw if requested to lower your entry numbers. Entry fees will be refunded for any requested withdrawals made by the RASV.

CATALOGUES

Each Exhibitor is to pre purchase one Catalogue with their initial entry. Upon arrival at the Showgrounds you will be given your Catalogue, which will be included in your Exhibitor Pack. The RASV is heading towards a more sustainable environmental footprint and as such, there will be a limited number of catalogues available for sale at the Show. The Catalogue will be available on the RASV website.

ALPACA FLEECE

The Fleece competition will be held as a part of the Royal Melbourne Show in September. Refer to separate Schedule and Entry Form. Entries open Monday 3 June 2013. Upon request, fleeces can be sent from the RASV to the Nationals in Bendigo.

DISPLAYS

Breeders are invited to participate in the alpaca display activities being conducted throughout the duration of the Royal Melbourne Show, Saturday 21 September – Wednesday 2 October 2013.

These animal displays will compliment alpaca fleece, product, spinning and other alpaca information sessions.

SPECIAL NOTE / IN MEMORIAM

Dianne Condon

The RASV Alpaca Committee recognises the passing of Dianne Condon, a valued member of the alpaca community. To mark her passion for the breed The Friends of Dianne Condon have sponsored the following award at this year's Royal Melbourne Alpaca Show;

Dianne Condon Memorial Perpetual Cup for

Best White Huacaya Female in Show

Dianne was one of the first members of the Australian Alpaca Association. She was part of the group that worked together to form The Australian Alpaca Association and was an inaugural member of the very first Committee. Dianne's passion for showing was responsible for alpacas being accepted as a breed of livestock for judging at the Royal Melbourne and the Bendigo Sheep and Wool Show and many other shows. She convinced the relevant show societies to allow alpacas to be shown at these prestigious shows. This was the start of our shows as we know them today. Alpacas have now become a popular attraction and competition at shows Australia wide.

She qualified and was appointed as one of the first Australian Alpaca Association judges. Dianne judged most major shows and Royals

REGULATIONS OF ALPACA COMPETITION

401. The Regulations appearing in this Schedule form part of the General Regulations and conditions of entry to an Event at the Royal Melbourne Show. In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these Regulations, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations provide otherwise.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES

402. Entries in the Alpaca competition must be received at the RASV's Administration Office located at Melbourne Showgrounds, Epsom Road, Ascot Vale, Victoria, 3032 by Friday 31 May 2013. All entries must be accompanied by the applicable fee, Alpaca Herd Health Status Declaration Form, Registration Certificate (both sides) of each Exhibit entered and Penning Information Form.

403. The onus is entirely on the Exhibitor to submit particulars on time. There will be no reminder from RASV staff.

404. In accordance with General Regulation 8.2, the RASV reserves the right to amend, consolidate or cancel classes offered in this competition schedule.

ENTRY FEES

405. Entry fees for Alpacas (straw inclusive):

\$55 per animal (GST free) for RASV Members

\$80 per animal (GST free) for RASV Non-members

406. The entry fee entitles the Exhibitor to enter the animal in all eligible classes. Please specify selected classes on enclosed Entry Form.

CATALOGUES

407. Each exhibitor is to pre purchase one catalogue for \$10.00 with their initial entry. Upon arrival at the Showgrounds you will be given your catalogue, which will be included in the Exhibitor Pack.

PARKING

408. Parking for vehicles, including trucks and floats will be available. Apply by completing the relevant section on the entry form, and forward the fee with the competition entry fee.

409. Parking fees for 2013 will be:

\$10.00 (GST inc.) for RASV Members

\$20.00 (GST inc.) for RASV Non- Members

410. There is to be no camping in the RASV Truck Park under any circumstances.

411. Any vehicle, including trucks, stock transports, trailers, and horse floats, located on the Showgrounds, or any area leased by the RASV, shall be at the sole risk of the owner. The RASV accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage, including loss or damage caused by negligence of the RASV, its officers, employees, or agents to any vehicle, or the contents of any vehicle, located on the RASV's property on the any area leased by the RASV.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS

412. Arrival and Departure times are as follows for Alpacas:

Arrival:

Friday 5 July: Saturday 6 July: between 3:00pm and 9:00pm between 5:00am and 6:30am

Departure:

Sunday 7 July: Monday 8 July: between 6:00pm and 9:00pm between 6:00am and 7:00am

As prioritised by the Superintendent – preference for earlier departure slots to long distance travellers.

ACCOMODATION

413. There is no accommodation available for this event.

PERIOD OF EXHIBITION

414. Animals must be penned by 7:00am Saturday 6 July 2013

415. Alpacas will be permitted to leave only after 5:00pm Sunday 7 July 2013

416. All Exhibits must be removed by 7.00 am Monday 8 July.

EXHIBITORS' MEETING

417. At the direction of the Chief Steward, Exhibitors may be required to attend a Coordination meeting at 9:00am on Saturday 6 July 2013 in the Alpaca Show Ring.

BEDDING

418. No bedding, other than straw, may be used in pens.

CLEANLINESS OF PENS

419. Mucking out of pens is to be carried out.

420. Exhibitors must keep the pens allotted to their animals clean and give proper attention to their stock throughout the Show. Exhibitors are advised to provide their own feed and water containers.

ADVERTISING

421. Decoration of pens is encouraged. Promotional signage is permitted within the bounds of pens up to 180cm above floor level. No signage or other promotional material may be placed in public access walkways.

422. Stud promotional banners may be displayed in the industry display area by arrangement with the Superintendent.

423. Display of Show ribbons other than those awarded at the 2013 Royal Melbourne Alpaca Show is prohibited.

SMOKING

424. Smoking and naked flames are at all times prohibited in all structures and Pavilions on the Melbourne Showgrounds.

REGISTRATION

425. A copy of each Exhibits Registration Certificate (both sides) must be included with the Entry Form. Failure to provide a Registration Certificate with the Entry Form will deem that animal ineligible for Exhibition at the Show.

426. Only the registered owner of an Exhibit, or his/her authorised agent may sign an Entry Form.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

427. All entries must be accompanied by the Alpaca Herd Health Declaration Form signed by the Exhibitor or authorised agent, and a Government Veterinary Officer if applicable. Failure to sign the Alpaca Herd Health Declaration Form will render all Alpacas of an Exhibitor ineligible to be exhibited.

428. The 2013 Alpaca Competitions will be conducted under the guidelines as set out in the Johne's Disease Market Assurance Program (AlpacaMAP).

429. Alpacas traveling interstate must comply with the requirements of Victorian legislation.

EXERCISING OF ANIMALS

430. Alpacas are to remain in their pens during the day and exercising is only allowed at specified times as nominated by the Superintendent. **COMPANION ANIMALS AND DOGS**

431. Animals not entered for competition, with the exception of cria at foot, will not be permitted onto the Showgrounds. Companion animals are not permitted. This does not apply to the display alpacas.

No dogs (except Guide or Seeing Eye Dogs) are permitted into the precinct where Show animals are being penned or shown.

INSPECTION OF EXHIBITS

432. Inspection of all Alpacas will take place on arrival or on Saturday 6 July 2013 between 7:00am and 8:30am. All Alpacas must be registered with the IAR and carry an approved brass tag showing the Alpaca's IAR number.

433. Every animal exhibited in the Alpaca section will be subject to inspection carried out by an Inspector appointed by the RASV.

434. The Inspector or Inspectors appointed by the RASV shall then examine all Alpacas for genetic faults, colour, class and IAR number.

435. If there is no IAR tag present in the ear of an Exhibit, official confirmation by the registrar (in hard copy) must be provided by the owner to the Chief Steward that the ear tag has been recently lost and that the new tag has been ordered and paid for. Replacement tag orders and payments must be lodged with the registrar a minimum of one week before the date of Show. Failure to present such advice at inspection will result in disqualification of the animal.

- 436. No Exhibitor shall, to the best of their knowledge, exhibit any alpaca showing any signs or symptoms of disease at the time of exhibition. All male alpacas must be completely entire and deemed physically sound. Any alpaca not deemed to be completely physically sound by the appointed RASV Inspector or a Veterinary Surgeon shall not compete.
- 437. The Inspector or Chief Steward will classify all entries for colour, and has the power to transfer an Exhibit to the class which, in their opinion, should have been entered. The Chief Steward will combine or split classes as he / she sees fit.
- 438. Alpacas not in their allotted pens and available for inspection at the official times may be disqualified by the Chief Steward. Exhibitors must be in attendance at time of inspection and will be required to assist.
- 439. Exhibits of Huacayas must carry a minimum fleece length of 50mm and a recommended maximum length not exceeding 130mm. The minimum fleece length for Suri is 75mm and fleece length will be assessed by the Judge.

Note: Huacaya 12 months and older must be shorn regularly so that no more than 15 months fleece is carried at the time of showing. Suri must be shorn regularly so that no more than 24 months fleece is carried at the time of showing.

440. Any animal found to have lice infestation must be removed from the Showgrounds immediately along with any other Alpacas present that belong to the same Exhibitor.

CORRECT ANIMAL COLOUR CLASSIFICATION

- 441. An Alpaca is to be shown in the appropriate colour class, when it is predominantly that colour. Any colour variations will be assessed at the Judge's discretion.
- 442. A predominantly grey Alpaca (grey, rose grey) is to be shown in a grey class, whether or not it has any other coloured spots present, and any colour variations will be assessed at the Judge's discretion.
- 443. Exhibits shall not have fleece of a different colour to that of the blanket removed from an animal to a level below that of the blanket fleece.

AGE OF ALPACA

444. Alpacas must be entered into the correct class at their age on the first day of judging, Saturday 6 July 2013.

JUDGING

445. The following regulations shall be read subject to General Regulations 10.1 to 10.6 of the General Regulations.

446. Judging Times are as follows:

Saturday 6 July

Judging: 9:00am -5:00pm

Sunday 7 July

Judging: 9:00am – 11:00am Judging: 1:30pm – 4:00pm

447. Section 1 through to Section 10 will be followed by all section champions "1-10" for the Supreme Champion.

448. The Huacaya Sire's and Dam's Progeny will proceed after the judging of the Huacaya Supreme Champion and "Royal" Colour.

449. The Suri Sire's and Dam's Progeny will proceed after the judging of the Suri Supreme Champion and "Royal" Colour.

450. The Judge's decision shall be final and the Judge has the power of withholding prizes from any Exhibitor not deemed worthy of that

451. All Exhibitors shall, upon arrival at the Show, obtain their pen position and class numbers from the Shed Steward. Exhibitor class numbers of the Exhibit must be worn and clearly displayed by the handler whilst in the Show Ring and must show age of animal in months and the number of months of fleece the alpaca is carrying.

452. All handlers showing animals must be competent in the handling of their Exhibit, or removal from the Show Ring may be requested by the Judge. It is recommended that children not Exhibit large animals that they cannot control.

453. All Exhibitors must place their animals in the pens allotted by the Stewards and must not be moved or removed except by order of the Chief Steward.

MISCONDUCT OF EXHIBITORS AND MEMBERS

454. A violation of any rule by the Exhibitor shall be reported to the Chief Steward in writing by either the Judge, a steward or exhibitor within one hour of the alleged incident occurring.

455. Misconduct may also be reported by the Judge, a Steward or Exhibitor to the Chief Steward in respect of actions of an exhibitor or member present at the Show that is considered to be prejudicial to the industry. Such actions may include but not be limited to:

- A demonstration of dissatisfaction with a Judge's decision, including refusal to accept an award.
- b) Altercations with Show Officials, Exhibitors or the general public.
- Abusive or foul language or rude gestures in public and the mistreatment of an animal.

456. Written complaints shall be lodged with the Chief Steward within one hour of the alleged incident occurring. Written complaints received by the Chief Steward shall be immediately investigated and if sufficient grounds for the complaint are confirmed the matter shall be reported to the RASV for appropriate action under the appropriate Grievance Procedure.

PROTESTS

457. The following regulations shall be read subject to General Regulations 11.1 to 11.7 of the General Regulations.

458. Only an Exhibitor may lodge a protest against another Exhibitor or a Show official. The protest shall be lodged in writing together with a deposit of \$50, which shall be refunded if the protest is upheld.

459. The sole grounds for a protest shall be a breach of the Regulations and protests shall be lodged with the Chief Steward within one hour of the alleged incident occurring.

The Chief Steward shall set up a Protest Committee prior to the commencement of the Show. The Committee shall comprise the Chief Steward as the Chair and two ordinary members not associated with the alleged incident. A meeting will be convened within 30 minutes of the protest being received. The Protest Committee shall immediately investigate the protest and if found to be valid initiate appropriate action.

DRESS CODE

460. All Exhibitors leading stock in the Judging Ring or on Parade shall wear a white coat, black trousers or skirt and clean closed black shoes. No shorts or short dresses, open shoes or hats.

461. Such white coat uniform must in no way show any insignia or any descriptive markings indicating the Exhibitor's name and/or stud name or prefix.

462. The Chief Steward may disqualify an Exhibitor for incorrect attire.

EXCESS ENTRIES

463. In the event of more entries being received than can be accommodated, Alpaca entries may be reduced. If necessary, the number of Alpacas from any one Exhibitor may also be reduced to a figure determined by the RASV. The Exhibitor shall have the right to nominate the Alpaca(s) to be withdrawn should this reduction be necessary.

PRIZES

464. Ribbons may be awarded up to 6th place as follows:

Up to 10 exhibits per class: 1st, 2nd & 3rd ribbons.

11 to 18 exhibits per class: 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th ribbons.

19 to 20 exhibits per class: 1st, 2nd, 3rd 4th 5th & 6th ribbons.

The Judge is under no obligation to award the prize where he / she considers in his / her absolute discretion that such prize, or prizes, are not to be awarded.

SIRE'S PROGENY CLASSES

465. Group of three males, females or males and females-(no wethers), six months and over. Not necessarily owned or bred by the one Exhibitor, but all the progeny of the one sire and drawn from the Ordinary classes. The class will only be conducted if there are at least two entries.

466. Only one progeny from any one dam may be shown in each sires progeny group unless the progeny have been born at least eleven months apart.

467. Entries close for Sire's Progeny Class at a time determined by the Chief Steward and the Alpaca Superintendent. Exhibitors will be advised upon arrival at the Showgrounds of this time.

DAM'S PROGENY

468. Group of two males, females or males and females (no wethers), six months and over. Not necessarily owned or bred by the one Exhibitor, but all the progeny of the one dam and drawn from the Ordinary classes. The class will only be conducted if there are at least two entries.



469. Alpacas entered for the Dam's Progeny class may have the same sire or different sires and must be born at least eleven months apart.

470. Entries close for Dam's Progeny Class at a time determined by the Chief Steward and the Alpaca Superintendent. Exhibitors will be advised upon arrival at the Showgrounds of this time.

MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR AWARDS

471. RASV Sash will be awarded to the Most Successful Huacaya Exhibitor (S001) and Most Successful Suri Exhibitor (S002).

472. The Most Successful Exhibitor Award will be calculated as follows:

Classes with 1 to 10 entries: 1^{st} , 3 points; 2^{nd} , 2 points; 3^{rd} , 1 point. Classes with 11 to 20 entries: 1^{st} , 4 points; 2^{nd} , 3 points; 3^{rd} , 2 points; 4^{th} , 1 point.

473. Placings in Sire's and Dam's Progeny Class and Fleece Classes will not be taken into consideration when deciding these awards.

474. In the event of a tie, two points will be allotted for Champion awards and one point for Reserve Champion awards. If a tie still exists, a count back approved by the RASV, will be made to determine the winner.



HUACAYA SECTION

SECTION 1 - HUACAYA JUNIOR FEMALE 6 - 12 MONTHS

CLASS 4000 - WHITE
