LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

EXPLANATION

WHEREAS The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Ltd has agreed to effect a Public Liability insurance for certain Animal Exhibitors at the 2014 Royal Melbourne Dairy Show, the following applies:

Insured Party: Animal and Livestock Exhibitors participating in competitions and events

Period of Insurance: From seven days prior to the Show until seven days thereafter.

Insured Activities: All activities undertaken whilst within and from the confines of the event venue consistent with the Insured's livestock

exhibit activity including setting up and removal

Description of Cover: Insurance in respect of the Insured Party's liability to pay costs and compensation in respect of loss of or damage to

third party property and death of or injury to third party persons caused by and arising out of the Insured activities, all

subject to the RASV's policy terms, conditions, exclusions and warranties, etc.

Amount of Cover: \$10,000,000 any one occurrence

Deductible: \$10,000 any one occurrence

Geographic Limits: At and from the event venue

Claims Payable: Worldwide excluding claims made USA and Canada

Insurer(s): Primary - \$10,000,000 Lloyds of London

IMPORTANT CONDITIONS

1. The Insured Party must exercise reasonable care to maintain all premises, fittings and plant in sound condition.

- 2. The Insured Party must take all reasonable precautions to prevent injury and damage to persons and property.
- 3. The Insured Party must give immediate notice of an incident which may give rise to a claim or of receipt of advice of a claim.
- 4. The Insured Party must not make any admission, offer or promise in connection with any claim and must not any time admit liability.
- 5. The Insured Party must make themselves aware of and comply with the following Notices:-

Duty of Disclosure: Before you enter into a contract of General insurance with an insurer, you have a duty, under the Insurance Contracts Act 1984 as amended, to disclose to the insurer every matter that you know, or could reasonably be expected to know, is relevant to the insurer's decision whether to accept the risk of the insurance and, if so, on what terms.

You have the same duty to disclose these matters to the insurer before you renew, extend, vary or reinstate a contract of General insurance. Your duty however, does not require disclosure of matter:

- That diminishes the risk to be undertaken by the insurer
- That is of common knowledge

That your insurer knows or, in the ordinary course of his business, ought to know.

Non-Disclosure: If you fail to comply with your duty of disclosure, the insurer may be entitled to reduce his liability under the contract in respect of a claim or may cancel the contract.

If your non-disclosure is fraudulent, the insurer may also have the option of avoiding the contract from its beginning.

Average Provision: The insurer will pay legal expenses in addition to the sum insured, if however, the total amount of the loss (less legal expenses) ultimately paid to the claimant(s) exceeds the sum insured then insurers will only pay (in addition to the sum insured) that proportion of the legal expenses as the sum insured bears to the loss.

Third Party Interests: This policy will only provide cover for your interest and does not cover the interests of any third party (e.g. financiers, lessors, etc) unless the interests of the third party are noted in the policy.

Waiver of Insurer's Rights: You must not enter into any agreement without the written authority of the insurer whereby any of their rights to which they become entitled as your insurer after settling or agreeing to settle a claim are prejudiced or limited in any way otherwise all benefit under the policy will be forfeited.

2. CLAIMS

- (a) No admission of liability or fault may be made in any form to a claimant. To do so may breach the policy conditions and enable insurers to avoid settlement.
- (b) Any notice of a potential or actual claim must be referred immediately to OAMPS.
- 3. Nothing herein shall be construed to alter in any way the scope of insurance policy, its terms, conditions or exclusions, issued by insurers.
- 4. RASV is not liable to the Insured Party in the event a claim is not paid or payable by Insurers unless RASV fails to take reasonable steps to advise that the cover is or is likely to be cancelled or not renewed.
- 5. RASV is not an Australian Financial Services (AFS) Licence holder. RASV is not providing financial product advice, has not considered the particular needs of the Insured party and no statement is intended to influence a person or persons making a decision in relation to any insurance cover. You should consider obtaining your own financial product advice from a person holding the appropriate AFS licence.
- 6. THIS INSURANCE ONLY APPLIES TO INSURED PARTIES ENTERING COMPETITION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GENERAL REGULATIONS.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DAIRY CATTLE EXHIBITORS

ALL DAIRY BREEDS NATIONAL SHOW RING CODE OF ETHICS

The RASV subscribes to the Code of Ethics devised by the Dairy All Breeds Show Ring Committee (ADBSRC). Subsequently, a number of regulations have been updated to reflect this, namely regulations 133 and 134. We recommend you review these regulations. The ADBSRC consists of representatives from all Australian dairy breeds and has the primary purpose of developing a national code of show ring ethics to ensure dairy animals presented for exhibition will be in their natural conformation and structure, free from modification caused by unethical fitting practices. We congratulated the ADBSRC for driving this initiative which underpins a national and consistent approach to conduct at dairy shows.

TIMETABLE

The timetable is subject to alteration and will be finalised once an indication of entry quantities for each breed has been received. Refer to the timetable preceding this section.

YOUTH CLASSIC ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry into the Dairy Youth Classic is FREE for those entered in the Ordinary Classes. Payment is based on spaces booked at the Show, irrespective of breed or event entered. For heifers not entered in the Ordinary Classes, standard entry fees apply. Entry forms for the Handler Classes (only) are available both via online entry and by hard copy from the RASV upon arrival at the Showgrounds through the Superintendent and will be accepted up until 12:00pm on Sunday 14 September 2014.

PRIZE MONEY FOR ORDINARY CLASSES

Prize money will be offered for all ordinary classes. We are still in the process of securing prize money supporters. If you wish to pledge your support for these classes, or know of businesses that wish to support your breed, please contact the RASV on (03) 9281 7444.

ENTRY AND NOMINATION PROCESSES

As in 2013, Exhibitors must nominate all Exhibit/s at time of Entry. Exhibitors will be able to substitute nominated entries prior to the close of substitutions.

If you no longer wish to bring a nominated Exhibit/s, please use the Substitution Form to advise the RASV of the Exhibit/s you are withdrawing and the details of the Exhibit/s replacing it. Substitutions will be accepted up until Thursday 4 September 2014.

CATALOGUES

Catalogues will be available for download from the RASV website. Additional Catalogues may be purchased from the Superintendent's Office for \$10 each.

BEST VESSEL CLASSES

Each breed Judge will nominate exhibits from In Milk classes to go through to the breed's Best Vessel class. A Champion from each breed will then be eligible to compete for Interbreed Champion Vessel.

INTERBREED CHAMPIONSHIPS

One Judge has been selected by the Dairy Cattle Committee to preside over all Interbreed classes. Subsequently, point systems will not apply.

DAIRY PARLOUR

The Dairy Parlour will be operating from Thursday 11 September from 12:00 noon. Further details of the Dairy Parlour, including the regulations for its use, will be made available in the Exhibitor Information Booklet.

MIDGET MILKERSThe utilisation of midget milkers will be accepted this year. All milking machines used on the Melbourne Showgrounds are to comply with current safety standards and must carry current electrical safety tags. The Superintendent shall make the final decision as to whether any machine is unsafe.

FODDER AISLES

Incorporated into the design of the stalls is a fodder aisle, which negates the need for fodder lofts or storage in the stalls. Please note that large square bales and small round bales cannot be stored in these aisles.

FODDER SUPPLIES

Fodder will be available from an onsite fodder supplier from Thursday 11 September. A price list and payment options can be found in the 2014 Dairy Exhibitor Information Booklet.

TRUCK PARKING

Exhibitor truck parking will be available on site free of charge. Please refer to the regulations for further information regarding truck parking.

CATERING

Catering outlets will be in operation during the event, for exhibitors and public attending the Royal Melbourne Dairy Show.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS

There is strictly no access to the Showgrounds for Dairy Cattle Exhibitors prior to 12:00pm, Thursday 11 September 2014.

Dairy Cattle Exhibits can arrive

12:00pm - 8:00pm Thursday 11 September

8:00am - 8:00pm Friday 12 September

8:00am - 8:00pm Saturday 13 September

8:00am - 12:00pm Sunday 14 September

All Dairy Cattle Exhibits must arrive by 12:00pm, Sunday 14 September 2014.

All Dairy Cattle Exhibits may depart from 4.30pm Tuesday 16 September. All Exhibits, together with equipment and personal belongings, must be off grounds no later than 9:00am Wednesday 17 September.

Priority may be given to those who have considerable distance to travel.

FODDER STORAGE

Exhibitors are not permitted to stack feed in the Livestock Pavilion except in the designated fodder aisles. Stock requisites can be obtained from the Fodder Merchant who will be situated on the Showgrounds.

CLIPPING OF EXHIBITS

A limited number of clipping frame spaces will be available, provided an application for space and a \$40 fee (inc. GST) accompanies the Dairy Cattle Entry Form.

Each Exhibitor is restricted to one clipping frame only.

ENTRY FEES AND BEDDING FEES

Entry fees for Dairy Cattle breeds are as follows:

\$43 each (GST free) for RASV Members

\$74 each (GST free) for Non RASV Members

Bedding fees for Dairy Cattle breeds are as follows:

ACCOMMODATION LOCKERS

Accommodation Locker prices are \$120 (\$100 GST inc.) of which \$20 (GST free) is a key deposit which will be refunded on return of locker key. Refund will be issued on return of key. Due to limited Accommodation Lockers, we reserve the right to limit allocation in an effort to accommodate all Exhibitors.

TRUCK PARKING

Parking for Trucks and Floats will be available. Apply by completing the relevant section upon completing your Entry.

Truck Parking fees are not charged for the Royal Melbourne Dairy Show, however Exhibitors must indicate on their Entry Form if they require parking.

There is to be no camping in the Truck Park under any circumstances.

REGULATIONS OF DAIRY CATTLE COMPETITION

101. The Regulations appearing in this Schedule form part of the General Regulations and conditions of entry to an Event at the Royal Melbourne Dairy Show. In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these Regulations, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations provide otherwise.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES AND NOMINATIONS

- 102. Applications for the number of spaces (animals) and section(s) each Exhibitor will be exhibiting, must be made on the Entry Form and must be received at the RASV Centre, located at Melbourne Showgrounds, Gate 5, Langs Road, Ascot Vale, 3032, by 5:00pm on the nominated Entry Close date.
- 103. All associated fees (i.e. Bedding, Storage Lockers, Catalogues, Clipping Frame space) must be paid at the time of entry.
- A completed Cattle Herd Health Status Declaration for Shows and Sales must accompany the Entry Form.
- 105. Nominations must be completed at the time of Entry with the name/s of animals, registration numbers, copies of registration certificates and classes to be entered.
- 106. There will be no late Entries accepted under any circumstances unless regulation 109(b) is complied with. The onus is entirely on the Exhibitor to submit particulars on time. There will be no reminder from the RASV.
- Exhibitors may nominate up to, and not exceeding, 100% of the spaces entered.
- 108. Substitutions of exhibits will be accepted by the RASV Dairy Cattle Section using the official Substitution Form up until 5:00pm on the nominated Substitution Close date.
 - Team selection can only be made from those officially entered and cannot exceed the number of spaces nominated. One space will be provided to each Exhibit.
 - b) Late Entries will only be accepted if the RASV Event Coordinator is contacted in writing on or before Thursday 4 September 2014. Late entries will incur a cost of \$200, in addition to bedding and other fees. Late entries will be accepted from those not already exhibiting. Lockers for late entries will also incur a cost at the usual fee, but will only be provided if available. The RASV cannot guarantee to fulfill such a request.
- There is no restriction on the number of Exhibits entered in each class.
- 110. In accordance with General Regulation 8.2, the RASV reserves the right to amend, consolidate or cancel classes offered in this competition schedule.

ACCOMMODATION LOCKERS

111. Accommodation Locker prices are \$120 (\$100 GST inc.) of which \$20 (GST free) is a key deposit which will be refunded on return of locker key. Refund will be issued on return of key. Due to limited Accommodation Lockers, we reserve the right to limit allocation in an effort to accommodate all Exhibitors.

TRUCK PARKING

- Parking for Trucks and Floats will be available. Apply by completing the relevant section upon completing your Entry.
- 113. Truck Parking fees are not charged for the Royal Melbourne Dairy Show, however Exhibitors must indicate on their Entry Form if they require parking.
- There is to be no camping in the Truck Park under any circumstances.

115. Any vehicle, including trucks, stock transports, trailers, and horse floats, located on the Showgrounds, or any area leased by the RASV, shall be at the sole risk of the owner. The RASV accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage, including loss or damage caused by negligence of the RASV, its officers, employees, or agents to any vehicle, or the contents of any vehicle, located on RASV property or any area leased by the RASV.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS

116. Access to the Showgrounds and Livestock Pavilion is strictly limited to the nominated arrival and departure times. Please refer to these times in Important Information for Exhibitors.

ELIGIBILITY OF EXHIBITS

- 117. An animal shall not be admitted to the Showgrounds, unless it is entered for competition or exhibition.
- 118. Bull Classes are not offered at the Royal Melbourne Dairy Show. Dairy breed bulls shall not be admitted to the Showgrounds.

STANDARD OF EXHIBITS AND INSPECTIONS

- 119. The standard of Exhibits shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations pertaining to the Breed Standards as accepted by the relevant Breed Society and as approved by the RASV.
- 120. Every animal exhibited at the Royal Melbourne Dairy Show will be subject to an inspection, carried out by an Inspector appointed by the RASV.
- 121. Each Breed Society or Association will be invited to put forward nominations for these appointments for their breed, and these nominations will be considered by the RASV.
- 122. Exhibitors are required to have their stock attended and clean in readiness for inspection by no later than 8:00am on the relevant day. The Inspector(s) shall on the relevant day make every effort to submit their report by 1:00pm to the RASV.
- 123. No Exhibitor shall be permitted to exhibit any cattle bearing marking brands or tattoos not consistent with those shown on the relevant entry form or Breed Society records.
- 124. Exhibitors are strongly advised to inspect marking brands and tattoos prior to lodging entry forms and before departure for the Show.
- 125. Without prejudice to any other applicable rules, if the relevant Inspector determines that any animal entered for exhibition:
 - a) is not true to type; or
 - is not of sufficient merit as to be worthy of exhibit in the class or classes for which it is entered; or
 - c) has not been adequately prepared for the Show; or
 - d) bears any marking brand or tattoo inconsistent with the markings brand or tattoo disclosed in the relevant entry form or Breed Society records or whose tattoo is not clearly legible; or
 - e) is in breach of the rules under the heading "Tampering of Exhibits";

then such animal shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show.

- 126. Any animal infected by ringworm or warts shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show. The Inspectors shall report any animal which they believe to be infected by ringworm or warts and the RASV's Veterinary Surgeon shall inspect such animal for the purpose of determining whether the animal is so infected.
- 127. Without prejudice to the General Regulations, the determinations of the Inspectors or of the Veterinary Surgeons on any matter shall be subject only to appeal to the Chief Steward in the Dairy Cattle Section who shall make such determinations and directions as they deem appropriate. Such appeal shall be accompanied with a deposit of \$50 which may be forfeited to the RASV if in the sole opinion of the Chief Steward the appeal is unfounded, frivolous or vexatious.
- 128. The Inspectors, Veterinary Surgeons, Chief Stewards, or their assistants shall not be required to furnish to the Exhibitor any reasons for their determinations or directions nor to give the Exhibitor any right to be heard on any matter in question.



- 129. Notwithstanding any other provision in the regulations, where the RASV determines that any animal entered in the Dairy Cattle Section has received hormones, then such animal shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show. Any determination made by the RASV pursuant to this regulation shall be final.
- 130. The RASV may make or cause to be made, at any time during the period of exhibition, an inspection or any test of an Exhibit to determine whether a breach of the regulations under the heading of Standard of Exhibits and Inspections has occurred. If, as a result of a breach of any of these regulations, an animal is deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show, the RASV may by notice to the Exhibitor require the animal be forthwith removed from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor, upon receipt of such notice, shall forthwith remove such animal and, failing such removal by him within the time prescribed by the RASV, the RASV may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the RASV. Any determination made by the RASV pursuant to this regulation shall be final.
- 131. If an award has been made to an Exhibit deemed to be ineligible under these regulations, any prize awarded will be forfeited and, subject to General Regulation 10.5, Exhibits in the next order may be promoted to that prize.

TAMPERING OF EXHIBITS

- 132. Notwithstanding General Regulation 7.4, no Exhibitor shall be permitted to exhibit any cattle which, in the opinion of the RASV, displays evidence of being tampered with or, in the definition of the class in which it is entered, an animal entered for exhibition or competition is not presented in its natural conformation and has no preparation other than normal feeding and fitting with the exception of normal dressing of hair, hoofs and horns.
- 133. The following practices are strictly prohibited:
 - Treating an animal externally including the udder with an irritant or other foreign substance not registered for use on cattle within the Commonwealth of Australia, stimulating device or electrical appliance.
 - Surgically or unethically inserting any prohibited chemical, drug, gas, liquid (including milk), matter of foreign substance into the udder to artificially enhance or change the natural shape or appearance of the udder. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - i) Dextrose
 - ii) Pure alcohol
 - iii) Gas of any sort
 - iv) Foam
 - v) Silver protein
 - vi) Silver nitrate
 - vii) Transferring milk between quarters
 - Using device or product to artificially create or enhance the udder crease
 - Administering an injected or applied anesthetic to alter the carriage of the tail or other body parts
 - e) Surgically or unethically inserting any matter of foreign substance under the skin or into any body cavity to change the natural contour or appearance of the animal's body. This includes the administration of body fluids by stomach tube or other similar device unless performed under the direct supervision of the show veterinarian for medical treatment
 - f) Manipulation of the teat by surgically or unethically inserting or applying any object or foreign substance to alter its normal direction such as to unnaturally hold plumb or to alter its length (i.e. teat setting).
 - g) Excessively manipulating top line and/or tail head hair beyond 3.80 centimeters (1.5 inches). Exhibitors have only one opportunity per show to check-in ringside and the animal will not be allowed in the ring for the duration of the show.

- Use of the following drugs is not permitted by any circumstances before or during the show includes, but is not limited to:
 - Any drug not registered for use on cattle in Australia
 - ii. Anabolic steroids
 - iii. Growth or milk promoting hormones other than those in Regulation 139(g)
 - iv. Diuretics and sedatives other than those in Regulation 139(g)
 - v. Amphetamines
 - vi. Prescribed drugs without a veterinarians label attached
 - vii. Prescribed drugs with a veterinarians label attached but used outside the normal time frame allowed for the use of that drug or drugs not used in accordance with the label instructions
 - viii. Drugs used from an unmarked bottle, tube or container
 - ix. Any drug that is illicit or illegal in Australia
- 134. Dairy cattle exhibitions are conducted under standards for evaluating conformation established by various Breed Societies with specific breed characteristics taken into consideration by the show judge. In this connection, animals will be groomed and prepared for the Judge's evaluation in order to display the animal's natural contour, confirmation, performance and mobility. Specifically:
 - External applications of cosmetics that affect only appearance may be used, including hoof polishes, hoof trimming, glitter, hair products on the top line and other areas of the animal.
 - b) Fake switches are permitted.
 - c) The use of imitation or artificial hair is permitted for use on the top line and tail head provided Regulation 138(g) herein is not contravened.
 - d) Teat sealing (with a teat sealant registered for the use on cattle within the Commonwealth of Australia) is permitted but the practice is not encouraged. Teat sealants are only to be used according to the manufacturer's application protocols.
 - The use of udder treatments is allowed provided the product is registered for use of cattle within the Commonwealth of Australia.
 - f) The following allowed practices require an Exhibitor Declaration (see appendix) to be completed and returned to the Superintendent before an animal is allowed to enter the ring
 - i. The use of intra-urine and intra-vaginal controlled drug release devices is allowed but exhibitors must complete an Exhibitor Declaration declaring the use of such a device and including the name of the ET technician or vet involved in the case of an ET program. Only one such device is allowable and Dairy Cattle are subject to examination.
 - ii. The use of drugs before and during a show is allowed under certain conditions. All pharmaceuticals and nutraceuticals must be delivered according to label instructions, including dose rate, frequency of use, method of application and purpose.



- g) Drugs allowed that have been prescribed by a veterinarian based on a therapeutic need as part of an animal treatment plan and declared in the Exhibitor Declaration:
 - Anti-inflammatories (Flunixin meglumine, Meloxicam, Tolfenamic acid, Ketoprofen, Dexamethsasone)
 - ii. Antibiotics, including intramammary antibiotics
 - iii. Diuretics (Furosemide (INN), Frusemide (BNN))
 - iv. Anti-histamines (Tripelennamine HCI, Chlorpheniramine maleate)
 - v. Sedatives (xylazine, acepromozine)
 - vi. Hormones (Oxytocin, Prostaglandin, Gonadatrophin (GnRH))
- h) Substances allowed without an exhibitor declaration:
 - i. Vitamins and minerals
 - ii. Glucose
- 135. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to ensure the animal is not subject to prohibited practices, prior to and whilst on the Showgrounds.
- 136. The RASV may make or cause to be made, any test of any Exhibit to determine whether any drug or other substance has been administered to the Exhibit and may take possession of any such Exhibit for any of the aforesaid purposes and detain such Exhibit for such period as the RASV deems necessary. Procedures for the testing of prohibited substances may include random tests on Exhibits.
- Should a positive test to a prohibited substance or practice result, any costs associated with testing will be borne by the Exhibitor.
- 138. In accordance with General Regulation 7.1, should a positive test to a prohibited substance or practice result, the RASV reserves the right to forfeit an award.

TINTING AND/OR COLOURING OF COAT

139. Should the RASV or appointed Inspector, be of the opinion that the coat of any Exhibit has been tinted and/or coloured in any way, then such an animal shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show.

HEALTH DECLARATION

- All exhibits must be declared free of Brucellosis, Johne's disease and other notifiable diseases.
- 141. As a condition of entry, all cattle Exhibitors are to provide a fully correct Cattle Herd Health Status Declaration. The Cattle Herd Health Declaration must be completed and signed at time of entry by the Exhibitor or agent of the Exhibitor, who in doing so, accepts personal responsibility for its truth and accuracy.
- 142. Cattle entered from any State or Territory of Australia are eligible for entry provided that they originate from herds or properties that:
 - a) are not known or suspected to have had Johne's disease; or
 - are currently participating in the National Johne's Disease Market Assurance Program (Cattle MAP) or are from a Protected or Free Zone; or
 - have been Check Tested (CT), Tested to MAP Standards (TMS) or Tested 4 year old (T4YO) with negative results in the past 12 months; or
 - d) are under strict regulatory control and;
 - have been enrolled in official, audited test and control programs for a minimum of 2 years; and
 - at least 2 consecutive annual whole herd tests have been conducted with a reactor rate not exceeding 1.5% at the latest herd test; and
 - the cattle to be exhibited, or their dams, have been tested with negative results as part of at least the last 2 annual herd tests; and
 - iv) the cattle to be exhibited are not officially listed as "at risk" cattle for the particular herd; and

- the cattle to be exhibited have been tested negative within 3 months of entry to the Show.
- 143. Cattle entered must not be subject to quarantine or restriction with respect to any other notifiable disease.
- 144. All Exhibitors must provide the Property Identification Code (PIC) for the property/properties where the cattle originate from.

REGISTRATION

- 145. No pending registrations will be accepted.
- All exhibits must be entered in the name of the registered owner.

NECK NUMBERS

- 147. Neck numbers corresponding to the Exhibit numbers in the catalogue must be worn by the Exhibits when entering the ring to appear before the Judge or when otherwise required.
- 148. Neck numbers must be obtained by the Exhibitor from the Cattle Superintendent's Office.

ABSENCE OF EXHIBIT

- 149. Notwithstanding Regulations 5.1 and 5.2, Exhibitors may withdraw exhibits provided that written notification is given to the RASV by 5:00pm on the nominated Withdrawal Date. The full bedding fee will be refunded for each head of cattle withdrawn in writing by this time.
- 150. Where any Exhibitor fails to show any exhibit entered in the Show, and it has not been withdrawn in writing by 5:00pm Thursday 4 September 2014, the Exhibitor will be required to pay a fine of \$50 per exhibit not shown, unless the failure to exhibit is due to one of the reasons specified in General Regulations and such reason is accepted by the RASV. Any such late notification of withdrawal must be in writing, and delivered to the Cattle Superintendent's Office on the day of arrival.
- 151. If an Exhibitor fails to show any Exhibit entered in the Show without having given notice in accordance with these Regulations, that Exhibitor may be prohibited from showing any exhibit in any section of the Show.

HOURS OF OPENING OF PAVILIONS AND CLEANING

- 152. The Livestock Pavilion will be opened to the public from 8:30am to 8:30pm daily, unless closed by the Cattle Superintendent or RASV staff.
- Exhibitors shall, to the satisfaction of the Cattle Superintendent;
 - Keep each stall allotted to them and their stock in a clean and proper condition throughout the Show.
 - b) Clean out their stalls each day, no later than the times specified in circular advice to Exhibitors.
 - Clean their area regularly. Refuse must be deposited in the manure bins provided. Manure must not be deposited in the alleyways or general purpose rubbish bins.
 - d) General purpose rubbish must not be deposited in manure bins.
 - e) To assist in the transfer of manure to the bins provided, please bring own cleaning tools.
 - Stock must not be left unattended outside pavilions at any time.
- Dairy Cattle must not be rugged between the hours of 10:00am and 6:00pm.

BEDDING

- 155. The following regulations apply to bedding costs and bedding
 - Straw bedding will be provided for Dairy Cattle on the Showgrounds.
 - Exhibitors are required to pay a bedding fee at the time of submitting Entry Forms.

RASV DAIRY CATTLE

FODDER STORAGE

156. Exhibitors are not permitted to stack feed in the Livestock Pavilion except in the designated fodder aisles. Stock requisites can be obtained from the Fodder Merchant who will be situated on the Showgrounds.

CLIPPING OF EXHIBITS

- 157. A limited number of clipping frame spaces will be available, provided an application for space and a fee accompanies the Dairy Cattle Entry Form.
- 158. Each Exhibitor is restricted to one clipping frame only.
- 159. All clipping frames must have secure flooring and face the front of the stall only.
- 160. Clipping frames must only be kept in their designated area. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in automatic removal of the clipping frame.

SECURITY OF ANIMALS

- All Exhibits must be provided with effective halters and be thoroughly broken to lead.
- 162. All calves must be securely tethered at all times.
- 163. Each Exhibitor shall ensure that each of their Exhibits is securely tethered in its stall.
- 164. All Exhibitors shall ensure that their Exhibits are not left unattended.
- 165. If in its absolute discretion the RASV determines any Exhibit or Exhibits of stock to be dangerous for any reason whatsoever, the RASV may by notice to the Exhibitor require the animal or animals concerned to be forthwith removed from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor upon receipt of such notice shall forthwith remove such animal and failing such removal by the Exhibitor within the time prescribed by the RASV, the RASV may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the RASV.

SALES AND NOTICES

166. Exhibitors are permitted to display cards over the stalls stating that an animal is for sale provided such cards do not exceed 30cm x 25cm in size. No other advertisements or notices (except by permission of the RASV) are permitted on or in any stalls or buildings.

STUD IDENTIFICATION NOTICE

167. Each Exhibitor is permitted to display one sign 60cm x 120cm in size provided that such sign carries only the stud name, address, telephone number, facsimile number and e-mail address

JUDGING

- 168. The following regulations shall be read subject to General Regulations 10.1 to 10.6 and 11.1 to 11.7 of the General Regulations.
 - a) Exhibits shall be present at the appropriate judging ring and ready to enter the judging ring at the time specified in the Timetable for the event to take place. Exhibits shall enter the judging ring immediately upon request by the appropriate Steward.
 - Persons in charge of Exhibits must in no circumstances leave their Exhibits unattended at or in the judging ring.
 - c) Persons in charge of Exhibits at or in the judging ring shall not address the Judge unless authorised by the Chief Steward or the Judge.
 - d) Judges shall have the right to order that a cow be milked dry before awarding a prize.
 - e) All attendants leading stock in the judging ring or on Grand Parade shall wear uniform white coats or approved breed uniform. Such white coat or uniform must in no way show any insignia or any descriptive markings indicating the Exhibitor's name and/or stud name or prefix.

FIRE AND ELECTRICAL SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 169. Persons who breach General Regulations 13.1 to 13.3 (Fire Regulations) may be required by notice from the RASV to forthwith remove themselves and their Exhibits from the Showgrounds. The Exhibitor and Exhibits concerned may be prohibited from entry to one or more future Shows. The determination of the RASV in this regard shall be final and not be called into question in any manner or in any proceedings whatsoever.
- 170. An Exhibitor, upon receipt of a notice pursuant to this Regulation, shall forthwith remove all his Exhibits and failing such removal by the Exhibitor within the time prescribed by the RASV, the RASV may remove or cause to be removed all the animals concerned and all costs and expenses of such removal shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the RASV.
- 171. Smoking is at all times prohibited in the Pavilions and in the Feed Lockers or any buildings on the Showgrounds.
- 172. All electrical appliances and leads must carry a current safety tag. Any electrical appliance or lead without the appropriate tag will be confiscated by the Superintendent.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

- The prize money advice slip issued by the RASV will denote each cash prize won by either class number or special prize number viz, (S123).
- 174. The RASV reserves the right to increase, alter or delete special prizes or prize money.

PRIZE RIBBONS

175. Ribbons may be awarded throughout the dairy section in accordance with the following table:

Up to 8 exhibits

4 ribbons

9 or more exhibits

6 ribbons

MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR AWARDS

- 176. Points will be accrued by the Steward during the judging of each breed, based on the allocation below.
- 177. Points are not accrued for Group Classes.

a) Ordinary Classes Point Allocation:

First Prize 3 points
Second Prize 2 points
Third Prize 1 point

b) Championship Point Allocation:

Supreme Exhibit

Championship Point Allocation:
Junior Champion 3 points
Reserve Junior Champion 2 points
Intermediate Champion 3 points
Reserve Intermediate Champion 2 points
Senior Champion 3 points
Reserve Senior Champion 2 points

c) In the event of two or more Exhibitors securing an equal number of points, the Exhibitor gaining the greatest number of first prizes shall be the winner.

2 points

d) For the purposes of calculating the Most Successful Exhibitor, when an animal receives an award and that animal is held in multiple ownership, the relevant points will be divided equally amongst the multiple owners.

e) A special sash will be presented to the winner.
