

# LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

#### **EXPLANATION**

WHEREAS The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Ltd has agreed to effect a Public Liability insurance for certain Animal Exhibitors at the 2014 Royal Melbourne Poultry Show, the following applies:

Insured Party: Animal and Livestock Exhibitors participating in competitions and events

Period of Insurance: From seven days prior to the Show until seven days thereafter.

Insured Activities: All activities undertaken whilst within and from the confines of the event venue consistent with the Insured's livestock exhibit

activity including setting up and removal

Description of Cover: Insurance in respect of the Insured Party's liability to pay costs and compensation in respect of loss of or damage to third party

property and death of or injury to third party persons caused by and arising out of the Insured activities, all subject to the

RASV's policy terms, conditions, exclusions and warranties, etc.

Amount of Cover: \$10.000.000

\$10,000,000 any one occurrence

Deductible: Geographic Limits: \$10,000 any one occurrence At and from the event venue

Claims Payable:

Worldwide excluding claims made USA and Canada

Insurer(s):

Primary - \$10,000,000, Lloyds of London

#### IMPORTANT CONDITIONS

- 1. The Insured Party must exercise reasonable care to maintain all premises, fittings and plant in sound condition.
- 2. The Insured Party must take all reasonable precautions to prevent injury and damage to persons and property.
- 3. The Insured Party must give immediate notice of an incident which may give rise to a claim or of receipt of adVICe of a claim.
- 4. The Insured Party must not make any admission, offer or promise in connection with any claim and must not any time admit liability.
- 5. The Insured Party must make themselves aware of and comply with the following Notices:-

**Duty of Disclosure:** Before you enter into a contract of General insurance with an insurer, you have a duty, under the Insurance Contracts Act 1984 as amended, to disclose to the insurer every matter that you know, or could reasonably be expected to know, is relevant to the insurer's decision whether to accept the risk of the insurance and, if so, on what terms.

You have the same duty to disclose these matters to the insurer before you renew, extend, vary or reinstate a contract of General insurance. Your duty however, does not require disclosure of matter:

- \* that diminishes the risk to be undertaken by the insurer
- \* that is of common knowledge

that your insurer knows or, in the ordinary course of his business, ought to know.

Non-Disclosure: If you fail to comply with your duty of disclosure, the insurer may be entitled to reduce his liability under the contract in respect of a claim or may cancel the contract.

If your non-disclosure is fraudulent, the insurer may also have the option of avoiding the contract from its beginning.

Average Provision: The insurer will pay legal expenses in addition to the sum insured, if however, the total amount of the loss (less legal expenses) ultimately paid to the claimant(s) exceeds the sum insured then insurers will only pay (in addition to the sum insured) that proportion of the legal expenses as the sum insured bears to the loss.

Third Party Interests: This policy will only provide cover for your interest and does not cover the interests of any third party (e.g. financiers, lessors, etc) unless the interests of the third party are noted in the policy.

Waiver of Insurer's Rights: You must not enter into any agreement without the written authority of the insurer whereby any of their rights to which they become entitled as your insurer after settling or agreeing to settle a claim are prejudiced or limited in any way otherwise all benefit under the policy will be forfeited.

- 2. CLAIMS
  - (a) No admission of liability or fault may be made in any form to a claimant. To do so may breach the policy conditions and enable insurers to avoid settlement.
  - (b) Any notice of a potential or actual claim must be referred immediately to OAMPS.
- 3. Nothing herein shall be construed to alter in any way the scope of insurance policy, its terms, conditions or exclusions, issued by insurers.
- 4. RASV is not liable to the Insured Party in the event a claim is not paid or payable by Insurers unless RASV fails to take reasonable steps to advise that the cover is or is likely to be cancelled or not renewed.
- 5. RASV is not an Australian Financial Services (AFS) Licence holder. RASV is not providing financial product advice, has not considered the particular needs of the Insured party and no statement is intended to influence a person or persons making a decision in relation to any insurance cover. You should consider obtaining your own financial product advice from a person holding the appropriate AFS licence.
- 6. THIS INSURANCE ONLY APPLIES TO INSURED PARTIES ENTERING COMPETITION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GENERAL REGULATIONS.

#### DATES

The Woodchop Championships at the 2014 Royal Melbourne Show will be held from Saturday 20 September through to Sunday 28 September.

#### **PRIZE MONEY**

Prize money as stated in the relevant Schedule includes GST.

A Recipient Created Tax Invoice (RCTI) will be created for Exhibitors who provide an Australian Business Number (ABN) and are registered for GST.

At time of entry, please ensure that you nominate your ABN in the space provided, if you have one.

#### ALCOHOL

The consumption of alcohol in the arena or dressing rooms by competitors is prohibited at all times. Any competitor found consuming alcohol shall be fined \$50 and disqualified from competing or participating that day. And at the discretion of the Steward-in-Chief may be disqualified for the rest of the competition.

#### UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR

An immediate fine of \$50 is applicable to unacceptable behaviour in the arena and further competition is not allowed until payment of fine. This behaviour includes swearing, temper displays, axes abused, abuse or obvious disagreements with officials, Committee Members, abuse of partners and disagreements with others.

#### **UNIFORMS**

All place winners must ensure their Woodchop uniform is worn for ALL presentations. Under no circumstances should casual jackets, jumpers or caps be worn during the presentation ceremony. Competitors may be fined for not adhering to this rule.

Uniforms must be free from excessive grime. Stewards reserve the right to request a competitor to change into a presentable uniform prior to their event. This means that clean white pants and singlets must be worn to each day of competition.

#### FILMING AT THE ROYAL MELBOURNE SHOW

Channel 31 (C31) has partnered with the RASV to produce video clips of the Royal Melbourne Show for daily posting on social media, the Show website and C31 television. Teams of film students will be at the Show each day to capture all elements of the Show for the clips. You may be approached by C31 to participate in their filming and it is your choice whether to take part or not. If you choose to participate a talent release form should be offered to you to sign as a record of you agreeing to be filmed for public viewing. The C31 teams have undertaken the media accreditation process and are seeking unique, lively and colourful content to assist them in expressing the

diversity that the Show has to offer. Your support for the film students is much appreciated.

## **EXHIBITOR FUNCTION**

All exhibitors are invited to an informal function during the Championships.

DATE: Thursday 25 September

TIME: At the completion of the day's events

VENUE: Woodchop Pavilion

# GRAND AGGREGATE TROPHY

The competitor gaining the highest number of points shall be declared the winner.

This trophy shall be decided on the points awarded to each competitor in the Grand Finals of RASV events, **excepting restricted events** and includes events 41, 42 and 48. Points awarded as follows:

1st: 7 points; 2nd: 3 points; 3rd: 2 points; 4th: 1 point

In two person events, the points shall be shared. In the event of a tie, the winner will be declared on a count back of the most wins in finals. If a tie still exists, a similar count back will take place in semi-finals.

# HANDICAP AGGREGATE TROPHY

The competitor gaining the highest number of points shall be declared the winner.

The "Two Garry's Handicap Aggregate Trophy" is named after Garry Stewart and in memory of Gary Smith and will be awarded to the competitor who receives the most number of points in all open Handicap events. The following events are not included; 1, 5, 6, 16, 18, 19, 25, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 39 & 43. The points awarded to each competitor are as follows:

1st: 7 points; 2nd: 3 points; 3rd: 2 points; 4th: 1 point

In two person events, the points shall be shared. In the event of a tie, the winner will be declared on a count back of the most wins in finals. If a tie still exists, a similar count back will take place in semi-finals.

# WOODCHOP SPECIAL REGULATIONS

The Woodchopping Contests are registered with the Central Victorian Axemen's Association Inc. and held under the guidance of Australian Axemen's Association Inc. Rules

- 101. The rules appearing in this Schedule form part of the Regulations and conditions of entry to an Event at the Show. In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these rules, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations provide otherwise.
- 102. Scratching's must be notified to the Woodchop Handicapper by 5pm on the day prior to the event. Competitors not notifying of scratching's may be fined \$50.
- 103. The logs and billets will be any variety of timber and any length approved by the Stewards at their absolute discretion. The diameter of all logs will be as uniform as possible.
- 104. ALL COMPETITORS must state on the entry form their last win and handicap and a list of their last four performances anywhere, irrespective of Association or State, together with the name of the backmarker. An entry will definitely not be accepted unless the last win and the last four performances for each class of event entered are stated on the back of the entry form. This applies to ALL competitors.

105. The contest will be chopped in heats and a final, according to the number of entries.

106. All logs and billets will be numbered, and will be drawn randomly.

107. The first and second competitors in each heat, unless otherwise stated, shall compete in the semi-final or final. At the absolute discretion of the Stewards, when there are two semi-finals, they may take one, two or three place getters to start in the final.

108. No competitor will be allowed to make any axe marks on his/her log or to the foot holes or dog holes before his/her handicap starting time as allotted by the Handicapper.

109. No persons, other than competitors and officials, will be allowed in the arena during the contest.

110. Axes must entirely sever logs in two parts; competitors who sever logs with the aid of pushing or pulling will be automatically disqualified.

111. Competitors must be at their places prior to the advertised time of starting. Events will commence at their advertised starting time notwithstanding the absence of any competitor.

112. Each competitor shall wear long white trousers, white boots or shoes and a singlet or shirt which must be of a colour considered by the Steward-in-Chief to be appropriate to the State in which he resides or appropriate to the particular event in which the competitor is competing, singlets or shirts provided by sponsors must be worn in the allocated events.

A competitor's apparel must at all times be kept in a clean and tidy condition throughout the period of the Show. Competitors in finals should not leave the arena between end of final and presentation of awards and they must remain in the same apparel. No advertising matter of any kind shall be displayed or be visible on the wearing apparel of any competitor, without prior approval of the Steward-in-Chief, except that the insignia or Coat-of-Arms for Countries, States or Association Show Societies, Clubs or other bodies may be worn on the singlet or shirt front subject to the prior approval of the Steward-in-Chief.

113. In any Association or Club teams race, the Association or Club uniform coloured singlets are to be worn.

114. Any axeman who holds the right to compete in novice events, forfeits the right to compete as a novice of an event when he/she has won a single handed open handicap event anywhere in Australia. This rule applies Australia wide and is irrespective of prize money. A competitor who claims to be a novice may be required by the Steward-in-Chief to make a statutory declaration to this effect. 115. The RASV may appoint a Disputes Committee for the Woodchop Competition and any decision of this Committee shall be final in all respects whatsoever save only for any decisions or directions of the RASV. No decisions, directions or determinations made by the Disputes Committee, or the RASV for the purposes of the Woodchop Competition shall be called into question in any manner or in any proceedings whatsoever.

116. Competitors must use clamps as supplied by the RASV in all Standing Block Events.

117. A Competitor who wins an event after the posting of marks may be re-handicapped for any subsequent event or events. The RASV reserves the right to re-handicap a competitor before an event has commenced.

118. Every care must be exercised to keep axes and saws covered. Axes and saws MUST NOT be carried among the general public unless so covered. Competitors should note the terms of rules in section 7 of the General Regulations. All axes shall have a pin (minimum size 3mm) placed through the axe as near as possible to the centre of the handle area.

119. Logs situated in a reserved area adjacent to the dressing room will be provided to enable competitors to test their axes.

Competitors shall not be permitted to test their axes in the pavilion. 120. In the Underhand events all axemen must finish on their logs. 121. In a Tree Felling event any axeman chopping in a previously cut board hole will be automatically disqualified.

122. Under no circumstances are axemen permitted to enter the Log Enclosure without the permission of the Log Steward.

123. In all sawing contests, saw cuts shall be started as close as possible to the front end of the log and shall not be more than 100mm in from the edge of the top side. Oil may be used on the saw immediately prior to the commencement of the contest. In sawing contests the saw must saw through the log from one side only.

124. In sawing contests the wedger shall stand behind the log and if any wedger in any way touches or guides a saw or touches or guides that portion of the log which is being cut off, the competitor or team concerned shall be automatically disqualified. The wedger's apparel must conform with Regulation 112.

Definition: "Behind the log" in this regulation shall be interpreted to

mean the opposite end of the log to the saw cut.

125. In the 400mm diameter butcher blocks one member of each team shall open a scarf and cut the log approximately half way through, the first cutting member of the team on ceasing to cut shall retire to his neutral area and visually indicate to his partner, in a manner prescribed by Stewards, that the other team member is to complete the cut by opening a scarf on the opposite side of the log. 126. Save only as provided in Regulation 115, any decision of a Steward with respect to any matter related to the Woodchop Competition shall be final and any regulations, conditions, rules or guidelines, which may be expressed to apply to the Woodchop Competition shall in no way be construed as limiting the discretion of the Stewards to conduct the events in such manner as they think fit. 127. Inscribed sashes and ribbons, presented by the RASV will be awarded to the first, second and third prize winners of all events. 128. Woodchop Competition event times and dates will be announced in the Catalogue.






