Conditions of Entry

201. The rules appearing in this Schedule form part of the Regulations and conditions of entry to an Event at the Show. In the event of any inconsistency between the Regulations and these rules, the Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the Regulations provide otherwise.

202. ENTRIES IN THE GOAT SECTION OF THE SHOW CLOSE AND MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SOCIETY BY NOT LATER THAN 4.30 pm ON FRIDAY, 28th JULY, 2000 WHETHER SUCH ENTRIES ARE DELIVERED IN PERSON OR BY POST.

PERIOD OF EXHIBITION AND INSPECTIONS

DAIRY GOATS

ALL DAIRY GOATS ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN THEIR CORRECT PENS BY 6.00 PM ON WEDNESDAY, 20th SEPTEMBER 2000.

ANGORA AND BOER GOATS

ALL ANGORA GOATS AND BOER GOATS ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN THEIR CORRECT PENS BY 8.00 AM ON THURSDAY, 21st SEPTEMBER 2000.

ALL GOATS WILL REMAIN ON EXHIBITION UNTIL 9.00 PM ON SUNDAY, 24th SEPTEMBER 2000.

ALL GOATS ARE TO BE REMOVED BEFORE 8.00 AM ON MONDAY, 25th SEPTEMBER 2000.

* DENOTES SPECIAL CLASS.

AN EXHIBIT CANNOT BE ENTERED IN A SPECIAL CLASS UNLESS IT HAS BEEN ENTERED IN THE ORDINARY CLASSES.

PRIZES: A ribbon and prizecard may be awarded, at the Judges discretion, to placegetters in all classes.

203. All goats entered in this Section must be registered in a herd book recognised by the Society or recorded in the appendix sections of a herd book recognised by the Society.

For particulars of registration of Dairy Goats in the Goat Herd Book of Australia, apply to The Secretary, P.O. Box 189, Kiama, NSW, 2533.

For particulars of registration of Angora Goats in the Herd Book, apply to The Secretary, Mohair Australia Limited, 4 Somers Rd, Malvern Vic. 3144.

For particulars of registration in the Angora Goat Breeders (Regd.) Herd Book, apply to The Secretary, Box 232, Berwick, Vic., 3806.

For particulars of registration in the Boer Goat Breeders' Association of Australia Ltd, apply to the Secretary, Lots 2 & 3 Schoolhouse Lane, Tallarook Vic, 3659.

204. If, in its absolute discretion the Society determines any exhibit or exhibits to be dangerous, for any reason whatsoever, the Society may by notice to the Exhibitor require the animal or animals concerned to be forthwith removed from the Show Grounds. The Exhibitor, upon receipt of such notice, shall forthwith remove such animals and failing such removal by him within the time prescribed by the Society, the Society may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the Society.

205. Entries are accepted on the condition that stock must not be removed from the Show Grounds before 9.00 pm on Sunday 24th September, 2000, unless authorised by the Society.

GST - ENTRY FEES AND PRIZEMONEY

The 2000 Royal Melbourne Show will be conducted after 1st July 2000, when the goods and Services Tax (GST) will be in place. Exhibitors and competitors are advised of the following implications:

ENTRY FEES AND OTHER CHARGES

All entry fees in individual sections include GST – all Exhibitors, whether they are registered or not, are to pay the full amount as stated in the relevant Prize Schedule and / or entry form.

Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim an input tax credit for GST. To assist with any claim for credit, we will forward all Exhibitors, on request, a tax invoice // receipt of Entry Fees and other charges received. Please nominate in the space provided and enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope.

At time of entry, please ensure that if you have an Australian Business Number (ABN), you nominate this in the space provided. For those who register at a later date, please forward your details to the Society immediately.

Prices for catalogues, lockers, parking and all other services provided include GST.

PRIZEMONEY

Prizemoney as stated in the relevant Prize Schedule, does not include GST.

GST will be added to the Prizemoney for Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes and have provided an ABN Number.

"IN MILK" AND "DRY" CLASSES AND SUCKLED KIDS

206. A Doe entered as "in milk" can be transferred to a "dry" or un-kidded class, whichever is applicable, if she has not kidded prior to judging day, and vice versa.

207. Does in milk must be at the Show Grounds on Wednesday, 20th September 2000. They will be fully milked out and stripped dry between 8.00 pm and 9.00 pm on Wednesday, 20th September 2000 in the presence of the Stewards or whomever they may appoint. The owner or his/her representative must be in attendance when Does are being stripped out.

208. The procedures for conducting the 24 hour Milk Production Tests are as recommended by the Dairy Goat Society of Australia.

Exhibitors in the 24 hour Milk Production classes are required to advise the Society before Monday, 11th September, 2000, of the following:

(a) The number of lactations completed by each Doe.

(b) Last date of kidding or abortion.

209. Judges have the absolute right to order any Doe competing for Championships to be milked dry before finally awarding the prizes.

210. Notwithstanding Regulation 7.7, kids not entered for competition will be permitted in the Show Grounds if they are actually being suckled by mothers entered for competition.

Exhibitors may provide their own mesh or similar, to create their own kid areas within their penning areas, prior to the 24 hour milk test and judging day, if required, for kids brought in suckling their dams.

PAVILIONS OPEN TO PUBLIC

211. The Goat Pavilion will be open to the public each day animals are on exhibition.

212. The following regulations shall be read subject to Rules 15 through to 19 inclusive of the General Regulations.

JUDGING AND PARADES

213. UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THESE REGULATIONS, JUDGING OF DAIRY GOATS MAY TAKE PLACE ON FRIDAY, 22ND SEPTEMBER 2000.

JUDGING OF ANGORA GOATS MAY TAKE PLACE ON THURSDAY 21ST SEPTEMBER 2000. JUDGING OF THE BOER GOATS MAY TAKE PLACE ON SATURDAY, 23RD SEPTEMBER 2000.

214. Exhibitors of goats shall be present at the appropriate judging ring at least 15 minutes prior to the time specified in the Time Table for judging to take place. They must have their exhibits ready for judging, and enter the judging ring immediately upon request by the appropriate steward(s).

215. ATTENDANTS LEADING GOATS IN THE JUDGING RING OR ON PARADE MUST WEAR UNIFORM WHITE COATS and the exhibit number of the goat. These numbers must be collected by the Exhibitors from the Superintendent's Office situated in the Sheep Pavilion.

216. After judging is completed, only prize-winning goats are permitted to take part in parades. All prize-winning dairy goats must be taken out on parade, in accordance with the printed programme. Prize-winning Angoras may also be paraded provided they can be suitably led. In any parade prior to judging, goats are to be paraded according to the following formula:

1-3 head exhibited	- 1 head paraded
4-6 head exhibited	- 2 head paraded
over 6 head exhibited	- 3 head paraded

No ribbons will be permitted on the exhibits on parade, except those won during the Show.

217. Persons in charge of exhibits must in no circumstance leave their exhibits unattended at or in the judging ring.

218. Persons in charge of exhibits at or in the judging ring shall not address the Judge unless authorised by the Steward in Charge or the Judge himself.

CAPRINE ARTHRITIS ENCEPHALITIS (CAE)

219. DAIRY GOATS will not be permitted to enter the Show Ground's unless Exhibitors provide a veterinary certificate to the effect that the goats to be exhibited:

- (i) are from a CAE accredited free herd, or
- (iii) have had a least one negative ELISA test after January 1st, 2000, and show no clinical signs of the virus.
- (iii) have had at least one (1) negative test after January 1st. 2000 for Johne's Disease and show no clinical signs (for goats over 12 months).

THESE CERTIFICATES MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE SOCIETY OFFICE BY 28TH JULY, 2000, OR THE RELEVANT ENTRIES WILL BE CANCELLED.

STANDARD OF EXHIBITS

220. The Dairy Goat Society of Australia Ltd (Victorian Branch) shall recommend to the Society an Inspector or Inspectors of goats entered for exhibition.

21. The Society shall then appoint a person or persons as an Inspector or Inspectors who hall inspect each animal entered. The inspection of Goats unless otherwise provided by take regulations shall be carried out by 7.00 pm on Thursday, 21st September 2000. whibitors are required to have their stock attended and in readiness for inspection on equest. The Inspector(s) shall make every effort to submit a report before 8.00am on riday, 22nd September 2000. The requirement to participate in parades (Regulation 216) pplies notwithstanding this regulation.

22. Without prejudice to any other applicable regulations, if the relevant Inspector etermines, or the relevant inspectors unanimously determine that any animal entered for ompetition:

- is not true to type; or
- is not of sufficient merit as to be worthy of exhibition in the class or classes for which it is entered; or
- has not been adequately prepared for the Show; or
- bears any marking brand or tattoo inconsistent with either the markings brand or tattoo disclosed in the relevant entry form or any marking brand or tattoo not in accordance with the records of the relevant Breed Society.

In such animal shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show and the Society hay by notice to the Exhibitor, require the animal to be forthwith removed from the howgrounds. The Exhibitor, upon receipt of such notice, shall forthwith remove such animal nd failing such removal by him within the time prescribed by the Society, the Society may emove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of emoval shall be borne by the Exhibitor and shall be refunded to the Society.

23. Without prejudice, the determination of the Inspectors or of the Veterinary Surgeons on w matter shall be subject only to appeal to the Chief Steward in the Goat Section, who shall ake such determinations and directions as he thinks fit, which determinations and irections shall be final and shall not be called into question in any proceedings or in any anner whatsoever. The Inspector, Veterinary Surgeons or Chief Steward shall not be equired to furnish to the Exhibitor any reasons for their determination or directions or to ive to the Exhibitor any right to be heard on any matter in question.

24. Any animal entered which can be proved to the satisfaction of the Society to have aceived hormones shall be disqualified. The decision or determination of the Society shall final and shall not be called into question in any proceeding or in any manner hatsoever.

RUGGING

25. Exhibits must not be rugged during the hours the Show is open to the public.

CLEANLINESS OF PENS

26. Exhibitors must keep the stalls allotted to their animals clean and give proper attention their stock right throughout the Show. Cleaning of pens occupied by exhibits must be simpleted before 6.00 am each day.

NOTICES

27. Exhibitors are permitted to display cards over the stalls allotted to them stating that an nmal is for private sale. These cards are not to exceed 1m x .5m. No other advertisement r notices (except by permission of the Society) are permitted on or in any stalls or uldings.

FEED SHEDS, BEDDING AND FODDER ARRANGEMENTS

8. In all Sections feed sheds are available for use by exhibitors at a charge of \$25.00 uring the currency of the Show. For the convenience of Exhibitors fodder merchants will st the Show Grounds to accept orders for stock foods, etc. Deliveries of stock foods must emade before 8.00 am each day during the currency of the Show.

EXHIBIT TICKETS

29. All reasonable effort will be made to issue Exhibitor tickets about a week before the bw opens. The exhibit ticket of each exhibit shall state the number of its box, stall, pen or and, as the case may be. This number shall correspond with the exhibit's number in the ificial catalogue. If the box, stall, pen or stand is not occupied by the relevant exhibit by on on the first day of the Show, the accommodation shall revert to the Society.

re exhibit ticket must be produced at the gate, when it will admit the exhibit and attendant the Show Grounds. It must be retained, and again produced when the exhibit leaves the rpw Grounds. Attendants passes may be issued by the Superintendent at his office on the pw Grounds.
