In this Section "Exhibit" includes Pony, Galloway and Horse as appropriate.

For exhibits entered in jumping competitions conducted under F.E.I. Rules, particulars of performance must be furnished on the appropriate form, extra copies of which are available from this office on request. **The performance card (or preferably a photostat of same) must be forwarded with the Entry Form.**

After the close of nominations, the Society will determine which entries will be accepted and for which animals accommodation will be provided. All entrants will be notified of the Society's decision, and any paid on nomination not accepted will not be refunded.

Riders may NOT ride more than two horses in any event.

Entries for Special Events 330 to 332 do not necessarily have to be entered or accepted for Groups A, B, C or D. Exhibits will compete in the catalogue order unless directed otherwise.

The order of competition will be posted in the Assembly area, for events where a draw is not listed in the catalogue.

A maximum of 25 horses will be accepted for Group A, group B and Group C. The Society reserves the right to reject or transfer any entry.

Owners nominating for Group D (for junior riders) should indicate Group D in the appropriate place on the entry form.

A person may compete as a Junior from the beginning of the year in which they reach the age of 12 till the end of the year in which they reach the age of 18.

Entry fee Group D: \$40 for R.A.S.V. Members; \$80 Non-Members.

In Group E, only the Masters of Hunt Clubs may nominate on behalf of owners.

All exhibits entered in Groups A, B, C & D in this Section must be registered in the Register of Equestrian Federation of Australia. For particulars of registration apply to the Equestrian Federation of Australia in the State concerned.

Riders of exhibits in Groups A, B and C must be financial members of the Equestrian Federation of Australia.

Riders of exhibits in Group D must be Junior Members of the Equestrian Federation of Australia.

The Council of the Society shall appoint a Ground Jury and a Jury of Appeal in accordance with F.E.I. regulations.

The Steward in charge has been authorised to scratch any horse if it is not ready to compete at the time directed by the stewards.

Owners desirous of scratching their exhibits for any event must do so with the Horse Superintendent at least two hours before the advertised time of starting. Failure to comply with this regulation will render exhibitors liable to a penalty of \$10 for the first offence and \$30 for second or later offences.

Owners entering their exhibits do so entirely at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society, its Council officers, officials or members in any respect whatsoever, other than the liability for refund of entry fees in the event of abandonment of any competition.

All events to be run over course and obstacles as the Society may decide.

IN ALL EVENTS OVER OBSTACLES OF ANY DESCRIPTION, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, RIDERS MUST BE IN THE 16TH YEAR OF THEIR BIRTH DATE.

DRESS

Ladies (18 and over)

In jumping competitions excepting Group D, ladies must wear either:

- Black bowler hat, black or dark coat, stock or collar and tie, breeches and black riding boots; or
- Hunting costume.

Gentlemen (15 years and over)

In jumping competitions excepting Group D, gentlemen must wear:

- Hunting livery of a recognised hunt club;
- Black coat with stock, white breeches, black boots; or
- Riding coat with tie, fawn breeches, black or tan boots.

Group D

Riders must wear hunting cap or hard hat, riding coat, tie, jodhpurs with jodhpur boots.

SPURS OTHER THAN DUMMY SPURS NOT EXCEEDING ¾" IN LENGTH ARE PROHIBITED.

DEFINITION OF JUMPING ARENA:

The Jumping Arena will, when practicable, be entirely enclosed, but if not, will be clearly marked with flags or some other easily recognised indicator. At all times the

Trotting Track will be taken as off the Jumping Arena. It will be the responsibility of all competitors to acquaint themselves with the extent of the arena and its markings before competing.

THE SOCIETY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INTRODUCE A STANDARD AT ANY TIME.

CRUELTY TO EXHIBITS is forbidden either in the arena, exercise area or elsewhere. A competitor found guilty of committing a definite act of cruelty will be disallowed from taking part in any further competitions at the Show where the offence was committed. The decision rests with the Jury and no appeal will be considered.

Rupert Metherall showed at Royal Melbourne Show from 1927 to 1973. He owned and rode some of the best jumpers in Australia during the forties and fifties. He represented horse exhibitors at the E.F.A. for twenty years.

A rider may compete in Open Competitions and Junior Competitions at the Show, but not on the same horse.

SELECTION PROCEDURES FOR SHOWJUMPING:

- Preference will be given to horses which have gained at least 10 points in the previous season.
- Riders will enter for their preferred division, however the final placement will be made by a selection panel established by the Horse Committee of the RASV based on the current seasons performances of the horse in an endeavour to establish even fields.
