

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE IN THE HANDS OF THE COMPANY BEFORE 4.30 P.M. ON MONDAY 8TH JULY, 1996 WHETHER SUCH ENTRIES ARE DELIVERED IN PERSON OR BY POST. ENTRY FEES: EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE STATED, ENTRY FEES IN ALL CLASSES OF THE DEFE CARCASS COMPETITION ARE: \$45 PER

BEEF CARCASS COMPETITION ARE: \$45 PER ENTRY FOR NON-MEMBERS AND \$35 PER ENTRY FOR MEMBERS OF THE SOCIETY.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. With the exception of entries which are nominated for Class 6, exhibits in this Section can only be entered in one Class. Entries in Class 6 will also be judged in their respective nominated led Class.
- 2. All exhibitors shall state on their entry forms
 - the breed, cross of breeds or mixture of breeds of each animal entered so far as this is known.
 the name and breed of the sire.
 - the name and breed of the dam, if known.
- 3. The Company reserves the right to reject or limit entries at their absolute discretion, at any time, and for any reason. In this regard, Exhibitors are advised that accommodation for exhibits is limited and that the maximum number of steers able to be accepted is 300 head. If entries exceed 300, it will be necessary for the Company to ballot entries. Exhibitors are also advised to read General Regulation 7.
- Exhibits must not show evidence of having had more permanent teeth that is specified for the class. A tooth which has erupted through the gum is deemed to be a permanent tooth.
- 5. For the purpose of this competition HORMONE GROWTH PROMOTANTS are not permitted.
- 6. The Company reserves the right to display all or any part of any carcase exhibit in the refrigerated showcase at the Meat Hall.
- 7. An animal or carcase which, in the opinion of the Chief Steward or Deputy Chief Steward, shows secondary sex characteristics will be deemed to be a bull and will not be eligible for an award. Any decision or determination on this question by the Chief Steward or Deputy Chief Steward is final and shall not be called into question in any proceedings or in any manner whatsoever.
- 8. The Company requests that all exhibits be polled or dehorned.
- 9. STEERS THAT DO NOT HAVE A PROPERTY TAIL TAG AFFIXED WILL NOT BE SLAUGHTERED AND MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOW GROUNDS PRIOR TO JUDGING.

- 10. Subject only to the General Regulations, the Chief Steward and the Deputy Chief Steward reserve the right to make such determinations and directions on any matter in relation to the conduct of the Beef Carcase Competition, as they think fit, which determinations and decisions shall be final and not be called into question in any manner or in any proceedings whatsoever.
- 11. ALL STEERS SHALL BE RUNG THROUGH THE NOSE AND AT ALL TIMES, SHALL BE LED BY SUCH RING.

GENERAL JUDGING RULES AND ARRANGEMENTS

12. All exhibits for the Beef Carcase Competition are required to be penned as directed at the Showgrounds (please refer to Cattle Regulation 106 for arrival times.) Any proposed departure from this requirement by an Exhibitor must receive prior written permission from the Company.

A Complete Timetable of Arrangements for this Section will be forwarded to each Exhibitor prior to the Show. Unless otherwise provided, judging will be conducted on Tuesday evening 24th September, 1996 in the VPC WFI Ring.

- All steers entered in the Carcase Competition Sections shall be weighed prior to judging. Weighing will take place on Tuesday, 24th September between 9.00 a.m. and 12 midday.
- 14. After cattle are weighed on Tuesday, 24th September, exhibitors have the option of transferring their entries to a different class from the original class entered. Exhibitors who wish to exercise this option must advise the Steward in Chief or his nominee in writing by 12.30 p.m. on Tuesday, 24th September.

JUDGING OF BEEF CARCASE

- 15. Carcases will be judged using the April, 1989 National AUS-MEAT Beef Carcase Judging System. The AUS-MEAT system judges and point scores all carcases within the competition. Points are allocated for weight, eye muscle areas, meat colour, fat depth, fat colour, fat distribution and where appropriate, marbling. Penalty points apply for carcases which are outside nominated weight and fat specifications.
- 16. Carcases that are outside the weight range of their nominated class will not be transferred but will incur penalty points at the rate of 3 points for every one percent of carcase weight outside class range. Those carcases that exceed their nominated class weight range by more than five percent will incur a maximum penalty of 20 points.
- Carcases will be priced using a price grid according to actual carcase weight, not nominated class. Pricing does not constitute any part of the judging system.
- 18. All carcases will be quartered for public viewing at the abattoir.
- 19. Carcases will not be penalised for bruising should any occur.

NOTE: Measurements for a fat cover will be taken at the p8 rump site in line with AUSMEAT LANGUAGE, 3rd Edition, April, 1989.

NOTE: Dentition in all classes refers to the maximum allowable teeth in that class.

ACQUISITION AND DISPLAY OF CARCASES

Depending on the number of entries received, the Company reserves the right to arrange the judging and display of carcases. All carcases will be purchased at ruling market prices for the particular grade of meat. A commission of 3.0 per cent on the sale of carcases will be deducted from Exhibitors Account Sales and paid to the Company.

CATEGORY DEFINITIONS: (in line with AUSMEAT LANGUAGE, 3rd Edition April 1989)

VEALER/YEARLING - A milk tooth animal showing no eruption of permanent incisor teeth - approximately 18 months of age or less.

YOUNG CATTLE - Young cattle have one, but not more than two permanent incisor teeth erupted - approximately 18 months - 30 months of age.

STEER - A steer is a castrated male not showing secondary sex characteristics with three or more permanent incisor teeth - approximately 26 months of age or more.

Judging of Beef Cattle (A & B Groups) will take place from Wednesday 25th September till Friday 27th September.

Judging of Beef Cattle (C Groups) will take place on Thursday, 19th September.

THERE IS NO RESTRICTION ON THE NUMBER OF ANIMALS ENTERED IN EACH CLASS.

All females over 2 years of age entered in Beef Cattle Sections must be either "in milk" or "in calf". The Company may demand production of a Veterinary Surgeon's certification that a female has been pregnancy tested "in calf", failing which the Company has the right to arrange a veterinary inspection on the Show Grounds at the expense of the entrant.

An animal shall not be admitted to the Show Grounds unless it is entered for exhibition, with the exception that a calf of an exhibit in a beef or dual purpose breed class may be admitted if born on or after 1st March, 1996 and is being suckled by the exhibit. Such a calf is to be the natural born progeny of the exhibit and be tattooed with its permanent ink impregnated tattoo if born prior to arrival at the Showgrounds.

All calves at foot must be eligible for FULL REGISTRATION in the Herd Book in which it's dam is registered.

Any cow found with a calf at foot born prior to 1st March 1996 or a calf not being the natural born progeny of the exhibit nor tattooed as required above, shall be deemed to be ineligible for exhibition at the Show and the Company may by notice to the Exhibitor require the animal to be forthwith removed from the Show Grounds. The Exhibitor, upon receipt of such notice, shall forthwith remove such animal and failing such removal by him within the time prescribed, the Company may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall be borne by the exhibitor and shall be refunded to the Company.

A bull or heifer entered in any class for an exhibit of an age under 18 months shall be ineligible for exhibition in any such class if at the time of inspection of the exhibit at the Show Grounds the bull or heifer has or shows, in the opinion of the Chief Steward or his nominee, evidence of having had a permanent tooth; or if entered in any class for an exhibit of an age under 24 months the bull or heifer has, or shows evidence of having had more than two permanent teeth. A tooth which has erupted from the gum in whole or part shall be deemed to be a permanent tooth.

The Beef Cattle Breeds are divided into Groups which are based on the number of animals of each breed exhibited at the previous Royal Melbourne Show.

Group A - over 40 head Group B - 26 - 39 head Group C - 25 head and under

All animals entered in the Beef Cattle Section must be registered in a recognised Herd Book of their breed and have a background of at least four recorded generations of their breed with the exception of **Braford** and **Brangus** which must be registered in a recognised Herd Book of their breed only.

The following regulations shall apply in the case of particular individual breeds.

In the case of **Beef Shorthorns** - no heifer born twin or triplet with a bull will be eligible for exhibition until such time as she produced a calf, and no dehorned animals will be eligible for exhibition. In the case of **Hereford** and **Devon**, all females not of age for adult registration must be the progeny of registered sires and dams and duly recorded as progeny.

In the case of **Shorthorns** all cattle shown should be either naturally polled or dehomed at the time of entry.

In the case of **Poll Herefords** all entries will be subjected to a six generation check for genital abnormalities known to the Breed Society and animals which do not meet the standards necessary to obtain the Australian Poll Hereford Society's Seal of Approval will be ineligible for exhibition.

In the case of **Murray Greys** only animals which comply with Rule 10 "Exhibition of Stock" in the Rules of the Murray Grey Beef Cattle Society Inc. shall be eligible to compete.

In the case of **Belted Galloways** only animals of at least 93.75% (15/16) breeding purity be accepted for exhibition.

In the case of **Santa Gertrudis** all females 22 months and over shall be certified in calf or have a calf at foot.

In the case of **Charolais**, only animals which comply with Regulation 13 "Show Conditions" in the Regulations of the Charolais Society of Australia Ltd shall be eligible to compete.

PERFORMANCE CLASSES

Performance classes will be available in the Angus, Hereford, Poll Hereford, Simmental, Murray Grey, Limousin and Shorthorn Breeds provided animals entered are registered with Group BreedPlan.

The objectives of the Performance Classes are:-

- 1. To make Show selection closer to practical cattle selection with Judges acting in the role of a buyer ranking a group of potential herd sires for use in a Commercial beef operation.
- 2. To promote improved genetic selection procedures for:-
 - (a) cattle breeders
 - (b) general public
- 3. To allow breeders to compare their cattle with others.
- To maintain the spectacle of the Show Ring and the interest of both cattle breeders and the general public.
- 5. To promote individual breeds and breeders, and, to maintain incentive for breeders to show their cattle.


