- Two colour print

- 25cm x 25cm print space (see designs for bag size)

- High resolution, Vector file of art work
- PDF file included for viewing at Melbourne Royal ®
- Mock up onto bag (as per examples)

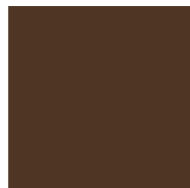

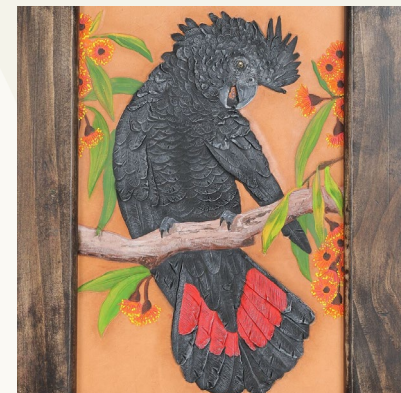
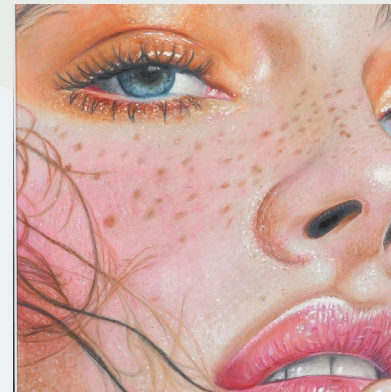
